

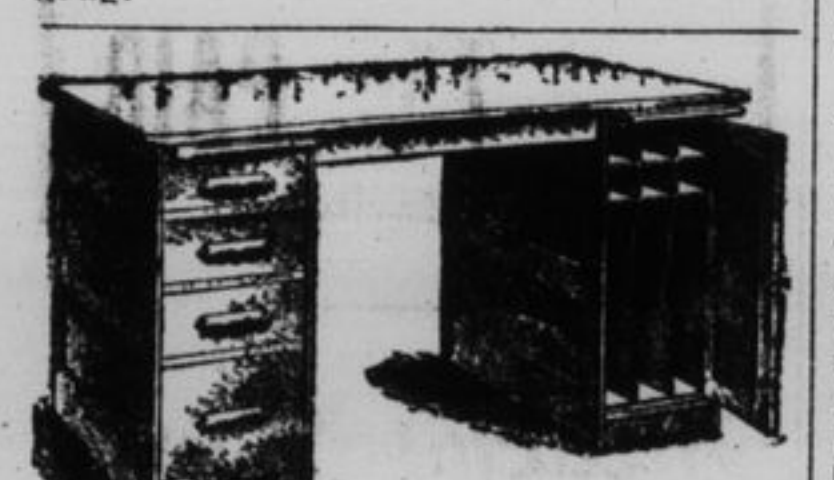

NAVY LEAGUE

Interesting Address by J. Fraser Wyatt—Aims and Objects of the League—Capt. Gaskin is President.

Four or five years ago the Whig suggested the formation here of a volunteer marine corps for the training of young men for the navy.

The attendance was not as large as desirable, owing to unfavorable weather and counter-attractions.

The Navy League came into being in England in 1894 as the result of a growing perception of three main points, viz.: (1) That the whole British empire, with its free institutions...

That famous work of Capt. Mahan, "The Influence of Sea Power on History," was the first factor in evoking recognition of the first point...

Therefore in the year named certain business men in London came to the conclusion that it was incumbent on them from the point of view both of common sense and common patriotism to do something towards making certain that the one great insurance of the whole empire, viz., the navy, was adequate in extent and efficient in administration to fulfil its enormous and momentous task.

With these objects in view, the Navy League was started, by men at first not very many in number, but quiet, resolute and in earnest.

The League has now seven branches in London, twenty-six in the provinces of the United Kingdom, and fifteen more in the great English public schools.

The League has now fifteen branches in the empire outside the motherland. Of these, there are in Canada, viz., at Toronto, in British Columbia, and in Montreal, the last named branch having been started, with Senator Drummond as its president on the 2nd instant. It is earnestly hoped that the

RELIGIOUS NEWS FROM OVER THE WORLD.

Buddhism Feared in Cuba—Protestantism in Mexico—Christian Scientists' Big Church in St. Paul.

The Bishop of Ontario will preach twice to-morrow in Montreal. Rev. J. A. K. McKee, late of India, has accepted a call to Renfrew Baptist church.

The revised translation of the Norwegian Bible has advanced so far that it is expected to be in the hands of the printers very soon.

Finland has a population of 2,380,000, composed for the most part of Lutherans, with only 416 Catholics and a few other denominations.

The Bishop of Ontario has issued a pastoral to the people of the diocese, to be placed with each family, calling for more earnest, loyal Christian support of missions within the diocese.

Rev. Joseph C. Hartzell, Methodist Episcopal Bishop of Africa, has just returned from a two years' residence in Africa. He has travelled 1,000 miles through the heart of that continent.

The Cuban press and the Catholic and Protestant churches are protesting against the work of the International Brotherhood of Logges, which is sending children to be educated, free of charge in its school in California.

The Methodists are, perhaps, the only section of the Irish population who will find any satisfaction from the detailed report of the Irish census. In the decade they increased by 11.7 per cent., but their total is only 62,000.
