MINERS SET GEYSER LOOSE.

Water Freezes and Forms Glacier Miles Long. Tacoma, Wash., Dec. 22.—After sinking a shaft 210 feet, two Klondyke miners struck a stream of water which suddenly filled the shaft and began overflowing.

Its menace was so great that the Yukon government sent engineers to stop its flow if possible. They have spent \$1,000 in capping the geyser.

The water came from a subterranean lake below the frost level. This shaft is the first one ever sunk in the Klondyke district below the permanent frost limits.

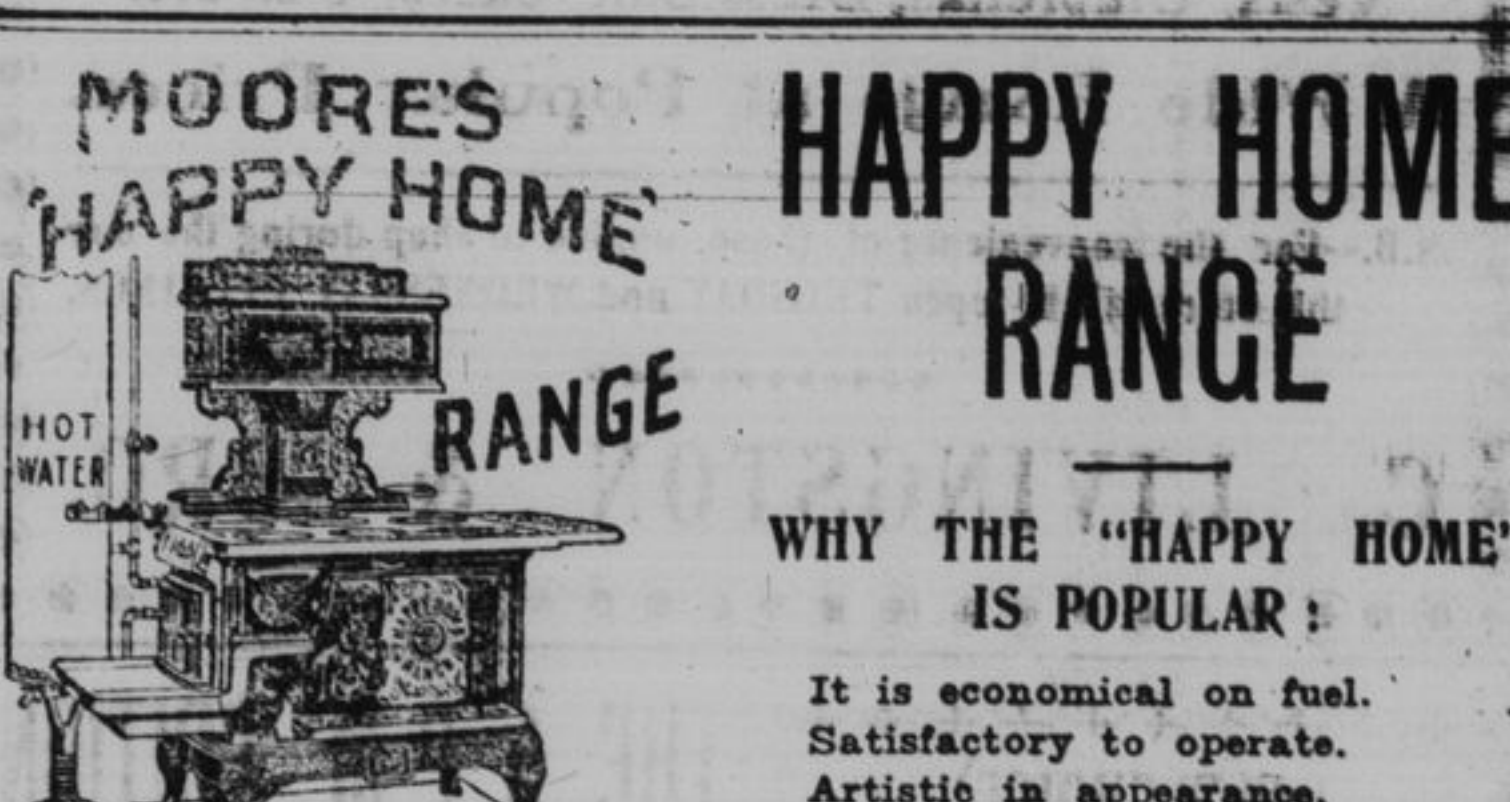

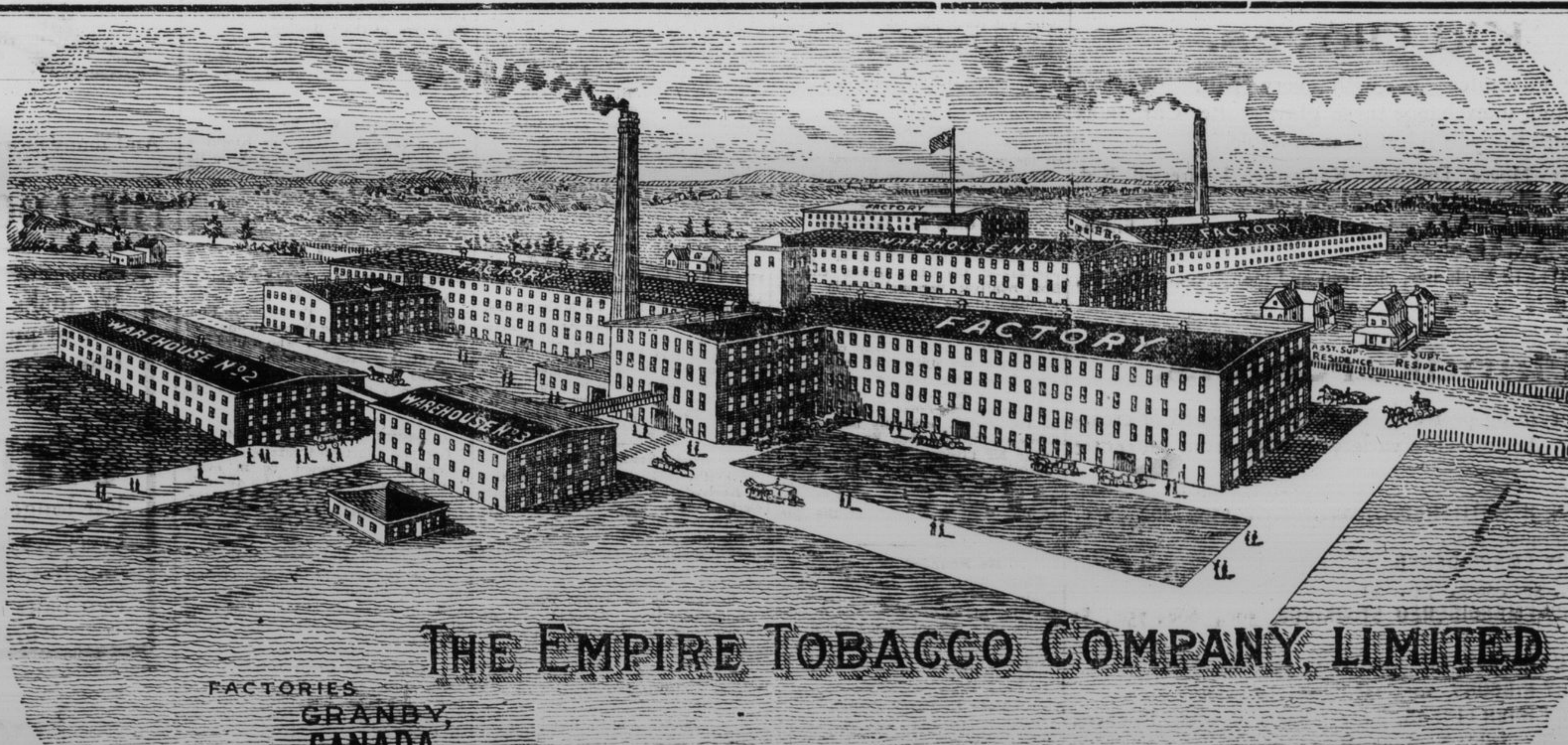
