STORY OF ITS ORIGIN AND DEVELOPMENT.

The Rock Formation Tells a Tale—The Elements Have Worn Away Rock Waste, Revealing Lines of History.

On Wells Island, one of the far-famed Thousand Island group, is a remarkable rock formation that tells the story of its origin and development in a most interesting manner.

The old shore surrounds an area approximating ten acres. It varies in height from one to six feet. Resting on the shore formation and covering much of its inclosed area is a sedimentary sandstone, varying in thickness at the shore line from a few inches to six feet.

Much of the exposed surface of this inclosed area shows glacial scratches, deepest where latest denudation is recent, indicating a depth of soil insufficient to hold moisture necessary for a liberal plant growth.
