AND PREVENT EXPORT OF MEXICAN CATTLE.

Inspectors Will be Sent to the Borders — Alleged That the Foot and Mouth Disease Exists There.

London, Feb. 11.—The board of agriculture recently received an application from the Mexican government to admit live Mexican cattle at British ports. The government made an investigation with the result that the government application was refused and the Mexican cattle is prohibited from landing. The government learned that the foot and mouth disease exists in Mexico, and also that Mexican cattle have been coming to Great Britain through the United States. It is understood that communications on the subject have been exchanged between Right Hon. Robert William Hanbury, president of board of agriculture and Secretary Wilson, of the United States agricultural department.

SUNDAY SCHOOL LESSON.

How to Secure Christian Self-Control.

The international Sunday school lesson for February 15th is found in I Corinthians viii, 4-13. The date is in the spring of the year A.D. 57, and the place is Ephesus. The golden text is Romans xvi, 19. In our last lesson Paul was at Corinth, and the present lesson is devoted to temperance. Paul's admonitions to the believers at Corinth are applicable to us to-day. Recall from the study of a week ago what sort of a city Corinth was, and think of the many questions of practical everyday life that would be troubled by a handful of Christians living in the midst of so many pagans.
