Long-Abandoned Properties Will Likely be Developed as a Result of Cheaper Process. Belleville, March 20.—Whilst gold exists in paying quantities, as has been shown in the miscal of the Hastings district, it is also found in many localities in the quartz, dolomite and syenite.
