Ontario's Fish Catch. Statistics From Report of Deputy Minister of Fisheries for Ontario. Mr. S. F. Bastedo, Deputy Minister of Fisheries for Ontario, in his annual report, gives a comparative statement of the catch of the various fish of the Province.

Revenue from the Department was \$40,149,707, an increase of \$4,253,100, the total expenditure for all purposes was \$33,514, an increase of \$953.
