SHORT SESSION OF BOARD OF EDUCATION LAST NIGHT.

Elliott Bros. Get Contract For Central School Iron Ceilings—Labor Representative Protests Against Shortening School Hours.

The board of education met last night, Messrs. McIntyre, Kelly, Elliott, Doyle, Lambert, Brown, Godwin, Wornath, McCann, Shaw, McKelvey, Donaldson, and Laturney, Principal Ellis and Inspector Kidd, on account of the absence of Chairman Wilson, Mr. McIntyre acting as president.

Communications.
These communications were read: From Blanche H. Gilbert, thanking the trustees for her appointment as public school teacher.
From H. N. Roberts, secretary-treasurer of the Boiler Inspection and Insurance company, submitting an offer to insure and inspect steam boilers in the city.
From Misses H. Lorena Chapman, Mamie Nesbitt and Mary Youngson, all of Kingston, applying for positions on the teaching staff, Management Committee.

From the Trades and Labor Council, objecting to the shortening of the school hours. Mr. Saunders was present in connection with the communication, and addressed the board briefly, stating that the workingmen's objections, and suggesting that instead of shortening the hours of attendance the home work be lessened. The matter was referred to the management committee.

From the department of education, stating that the grant to the Collegiate Institute this year would be \$1,255.18. Eyed.

Finance Report.
The finance report, presented by Mr. McCann, recommended payment of these accounts: Equity Insurance Co., \$3,24; J. S. Henderson, \$2.20; Menece & Minnes, \$12.64; R. J. McKelvey (expenses to Toronto), \$16.25; Kingston Coal Co., \$24.05; M. Wilkinson & Son, \$42.50; Bell Telephone Co., \$12.50; R. J. Reid, \$2.25; K. & P. Railway Co., \$1.43; A. Crown & Co., \$113.54; L. E. Knott Apparatus Co., \$21.90; Arthur W. Hall, \$24.00; J. C. \$25.65; D. A. West, \$3.75; R. Crawford, \$7.88; Map and School Supply Co., \$11.21; C. S. Linton, \$3.29; Joseph Jamieson, \$71.59; S. Anglin & Co., \$3.87; A. Langton, \$24.00; W. J. \$8.99; S. Heer, \$14.15; Joseph Scott, \$2.

Recommendation was made that no action be taken on the communication of the Canadian Casualty company, requesting a rise on the \$100,000 bond; that the request of J. W. Webster to the effect that Edith Meyers be retained as a resident for Collegiate Institute purposes be granted.

Mr. Elliott asked for information as to the latter recommendation. Mr. McCann replied that the girl had come to the city to take care of her grandmother. The report was adopted.

Management Committee.
The management committee report presented by Mr. McKelvey, recommended that F. Aylesworth be appointed an entrance examiner; that James Cruise be paid thirty cents a night as caretaker for the night classes during the past winter; that the finance committee be instructed to purchase certain text books and supplies for the public schools—Adopted.

Inspector Kidd's Report.
Inspector Kidd reported as to the attendance at the public schools for April as follows: Total attendance 2,197; April, 1902, 2,355; decrease, 158. Average daily, 1,869; April, 1902, 2,022; decrease, 153. Kindergarten enrollment, 297; average daily attendance 142. Cases of truancy, 5; suspensions, 2; new pupils admitted, 64, of whom 29 were recent arrivals in the city. Two hundred and twenty-three pupils have standardized their reading at the approaching entrance examinations. Teachers were absent on account of illness one and one-half days. Trustees made three visits to the schools, viz., Victoria, Rideau and Cataract.

In reply to Mr. Chown as to the decrease in attendance, the inspector said the chief cause was the great amount of illness that had been prevalent recently.

Collegiate Institute Report.
Principal Ellis presented the Collegiate Institute report: Enrolled attendance, 382; average attendance, 326; corresponding numbers for March were 387 and 320, respectively. In 1902, the registered attendance was 331 and the average, 304.

General Business.
Mr. Donaldson gave notice that at the next meeting he would move that clause 11 of the regulations be amended so that teachers if unable to attend their classes, should notify the inspector by 8 a.m. instead of 9 a.m. The property committee's report was presented as a motion by Mr. Lambert, seconded by Mr. Laturney. It recommended:

(1) That the tender of Elliott Bros. for putting iron ceilings in the lower hall and one room in the Central school building be accepted; (2) that George Payne be continuing as repairing carpenter for the year 1903-4, at the prevailing wages.—Carried.

The report of the delegation (Messrs. McKelvey, McIntyre and Elliott) to the Ontario Educational Convention in Toronto was read by Mr. McKelvey, and referred to the committee of

VESSEL RAISED

Another Success of Donnelly Company.

Floated the Steamer Wacohdah—Some Freight Brought to Kingston—Vessel Proceeded to Toronto.

This morning the steamer Donnelly with large Grantham in tow arrived back from Farrar's Point canal, and was caused at the Cardinal canal where the vessel had to lie for some time waiting to get through.

The Wacohdah in coming out of the current at Farrar's Point canal, lit the north pier and sank. She was drawing thirteen feet eleven inches forward and thirteen feet nine inches aft. Capt. Thomas Donnelly was in charge of the wrecking crew, and proceeded to get the hole in the vessel's bow patched up, this work being done by a diver. The Wacohdah was then pumped out, and finally floated. She was lightened of 100 tons of pig iron, 65,000 lbs. of coal, and 100 tons of pickles, the latter being chiefly for Kingston. This portion of the cargo was placed on the Grantham and brought here. The damage done to the Wacohdah will probably amount to \$5,000. Twelve of her frames were broken.

At ten o'clock last night the released steamer reached Brockville, and early this morning cleared for Toronto with the remainder of her freight. It is likely she will be placed in the drydock at Buffalo. She is 250 feet long and 40 wide.

Capt. Donnelly stated that most of the cargo was of a coarse nature and unimportant. She has fine work on the freight trade, he says, being handy and fast.

The raising of the steamer Wacohdah is the Donnelly Wrecking Company's sixth engagement and success in two weeks. May the good work continue in the company's prayer!

Another Evil Affecting the Public Morality.

Kingston, May 13.—(To the Editor): The note of warning was sounded by an eminent churchman, against a largely growing evil in our community, viz., the utter disregard for Christian modesty that is demonstrated by the posters that so liberally adorn our city walls, and the correspondent of a contemporary paper, has directed the attention of the public to the lower portion of the society.
