TO INSTALL SUBTERRANEAN OBSERVATORIES.

Instruments to be Lowered Into the Deepest Borings—To Learn More of the Earth's Phenomena.

Literary Digest. A proposal to install several hundred subterranean observatories at depths of anywhere from a few hundred yards to a mile or so, may appear sufficiently startling.
