PRINCE OF WALES OPENS SOUTH LONDON LINE.

Little Prince and All Paid Their Own Fares—Royalty Glad to Aid Schemes For Benefiting London—Princess May Wants More Shelves. English papers just received give extended accounts of the opening of the London county council's Electric Tramway lines.

The Practical Princess. The royal party was subsequently led to the "Prince of Wales" car, as Mr. Benn said it would be known, and amid loud cheers set off for Tooting, where their royal highnesses, in a special motor car, were to be met.

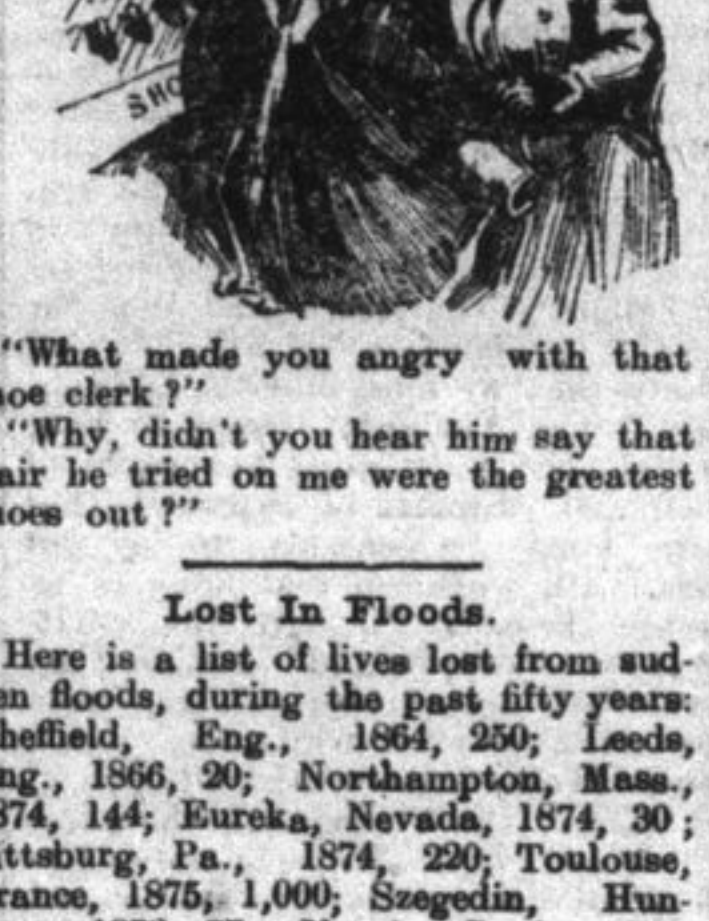
