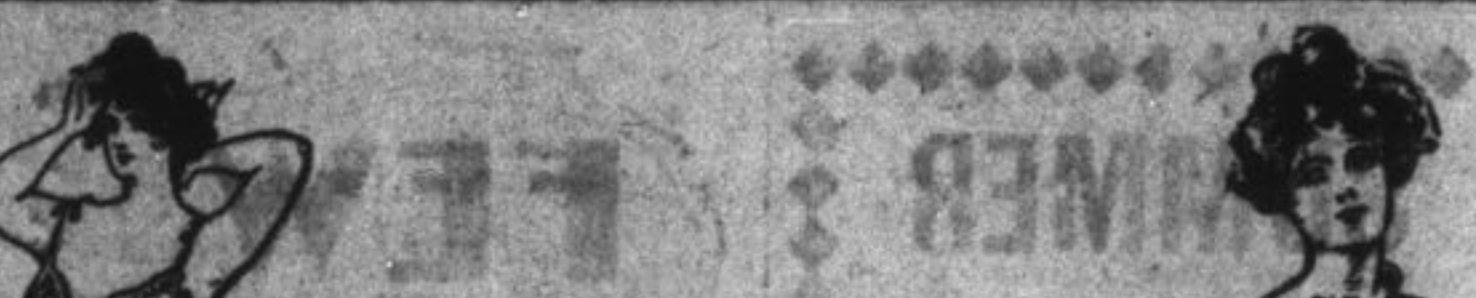

Spokane, Wash., Aug. 7.—A romance extending over a quarter of a century will come to a happy climax next Wednesday, when Helene Brinton Heyburn, United States senator from Idaho, will marry Miss Geraldine Yeatman, Chester county, Pa. Years ago young Heyburn met Miss Yeatman. In 1884 the young lawyer came west and settled in Veneta, Ind. He became a leader of the bar, acquired wealth and last winter became United States senator. Senator Heyburn has left for the east. A wedding trip to Spokane and Alaska will follow the wedding.

SIXTEEN KILLED. Madrid, Aug. 7.—By an explosion in a factory at Velez, near Malaga, this morning, sixteen employees were killed and eight others were seriously injured.

LETTER-CARRIER GETS FOUR YEARS. Montreal, Aug. 7.—Joseph E. Caron a letter-carrier connected with the Montreal office, was sent to the penitentiary for four years. He was found guilty of stealing a letter containing money.

FOUND THEM AFTER A TWO WEEKS SEARCH. Woodstock, Ont., Aug. 7.—John and Thomas Gustin, brothers from Otterville, arrived in Woodstock from Georgetown, and located their runaway wives. One was in the hospital and the other was living in a house in the east end. Up till three weeks ago the brothers and their wives were living in one house at Otterville. The men left and went to Georgetown. The women were to follow when they got the things packed. Instead of joining their husbands they brought the goods to Woodstock, where they have been living since. The brothers finally located them here after searching for two weeks. As yet the two couples are not reconciled.

ANOTHER OUTBREAK. The Bezers of China Making Ready Again. Manchester, Eng., Aug. 7.—The Manchester Dispatch, this morning, says that several letters have been received in official quarters in London, from different parts of China, in each of which the prediction was made that before long there would be another serious Boxer outbreak.

HEAVY HAIL STORM. A heavy hail storm passed over the surrounding district Thursday afternoon, damaging crops to a considerable extent. Rain fell in the city, but in the country there was the addition of hail. In Portmouth a village gathered a cup full of hail stones, some of the samples being as large as hard nuts.
