King Leopold has signed a decree appointing four Belgian officers to reorganize the Macedonian gendarmerie.

John McKeen, an employee of the Montreal Water and Power Co., was killed at Point St. Charles.

Boiles, the Denver murderer, under arrest at Vancouver, has been positively identified as the man wanted.

While on a visit to friends at West Townsend, Mass., Charles Vaughn, Myrtle, Que., tried to kill his wife and then committed suicide.

Shamrock, the trial horse for Shamrock III, has been sold for a price under \$20,000.

Letters from Constantinople and Sofia say that hundreds of Turkish troops have been killed in recent battles with the Macedonian insurgents.
