This English Woman Divides Her Time Between Fast Travelling and Frison Cell—Quite a Romance.

London, Oct. 6.—Convicted twenty-seven times for offenses against railway companies is the record of Mabel Truelove, a woman now serving a term of imprisonment at Stafford.

She has a mania for travelling on the London & Northwestern railway, and it is stated that she has explored every mile of the system. She claims to be as well known as the general manager himself, and she enters carriages and alights at any time to suit her own convenience.

Twice this week she has appeared before the Crewe magistrates, when her method was explained. The officials believe that she lives on the railway. She joins the fastest expresses, and when the ticket examiners enter the train she makes for the waiting-room. When not in the sleeping cars being switched from one end of England to the other, she is found in empty carriages, and she told the Crewe magistrate this week that the railway company had inflicted a severe punishment on her by attaching an engine to the coach she was in and had shunted her all over the country.

She was ultimately discharged, and in the course of a few days travelled from one end of the system to the other. She was found at Rugby on Monday at midnight in the Scotch express, and the officials did not give her time to alight. They followed her to Crewe, where she stated that it was most important that she should have got out at Rugby.

When she was brought before the magistrate it was said she had received a sum of money from the mayor of Crewe, and had purchased a man's suit of clothes with the intention of applying to the railway company for a situation as office clerk.
