A HALT CALLED IN WOLFE ISLAND FERRY SCHEME.

Antis Notify The Council to Cease Further Negotiations in the Matter of Having a New Ferry Built.

These promoters to be "something doing" in connection with the Wolfe Island ferry scheme, and the fun was begun on Saturday, when Reeve Fawcett received from the legal firm of McIntyre and McIntyre a letter forbidding the municipal council proceeding further in the proposed ferry matter.
