WILLIAM QUARRIER. THE CAREER OF A VERY NOTED MAN.

William Quarrier, known and honored as the "Muller of Scotland," died at the age of seventy-four, after a stroke of paralysis.

He was born at Greenock in 1829, and his mother being a widow, suffered as a child the privations of extreme poverty. As a little lad of seven, barefooted and foodless for thirty-six hours, he watched the heedless, well-clad passers-by in the streets of Glasgow...

At twelve he became a journeyman, and a few years later started in business for himself in Glasgow and prospered. His first step in the philanthropic work which has made him famous was taken in 1864, when he established a Shoelack Brigade in Glasgow...
