A similar decision was reached upon the claim of James Eaves, for damages of \$40 for injuries sustained by a horse by reason of an alleged defective roadway; the city solicitor advised no action.

FASHION'S FORM.



This model is designed for a serviceable, warm walking suit. It should be made in a heavy, close-woven cloth, either in navy blue or brown, or some mixed fabric would also look well. It is a jacket just to the waist, with two tucks down each side of the front and back and down the outside of the shoulders, tops of sleeves and hips. These yokes are cut raw on the edges and stitched on with three rows of stitching. The skirt is sewn-gored, with a tuck down each seam. The shawl collar, cuffs and belt are made of velvet in a shade deeper color than the cloth. The four fancy buttons down the side fasten with silk loops. The skirt should be cut in length two inches from the ground.
