NO SONGS FOR THE SOLDIERS.

Oppose Issuing Of Rollicking Lyrics For Troops.

London, Jan. 23.—Rollicking songs may be written for the soldier to sing at camp gatherings, and melodies with a stately swing may be composed for him to sing as he marches, but the treasury has forbidden him an official song book.

Col. Harrington Foot, the commandant of Kneller hall, the fine military musical school, where the hands are trained to play, thought it would be a good thing to have a standard book of soldiers' songs, something in the style of the "Soldatenliederbuch" of the German army.

Capt. Basil Hood wrote a fine, rollicking song, entitled "On the High Road," and Hamish MacCunn set it to just the kind of music that would help a body of soldiers along on the march. They could sing it with a swing, and there is heartiness in the words.

Mr. MacCunn gave the military authorities the copyright for use in the proposed soldiers' song book, and now, were looked up in readiness for the collection, a copy of which, it was hoped, would soon be presented to each soldier.

But the treasury shook its head, refusing to sanction the expenditure of a few pence on each soldier, and the project has fallen through.

The old stage coach that ran from New York to Philadelphia in twenty hours was christened "The Lightning Line," but all such travel as that became a very slow coach when Stevenson put his hand upon the throttle-valve and sent his machine over two iron rails at the terrific pace of twenty miles an hour. In that day who could have dreamed it would be three times twenty miles up hour in our own generation, or that the irregular beach, then crossed the ocean to Europe was finally sold as a cattle carrier, and superseded by the magnificent creations that now cross that stormy sea against wind and wave in less than six days.
