A COLD-BLOODED PROPOSITION

Should Weak and Sticky Be Killed OR?

Chancellor E. Benjamin Andrews, of the University of Nebraska, made a strange proposal in the course of a defence of methods of the Standard Oil company in crushing weak competitors. It was inspired by a discussion that has raged through the state on the advisability of accepting an offer of aid to the university from J. J. Rockefeller. It is contended by those opposing the offer that the university should be supported by taxation, and not by donations from men, who might in time influence educational methods. The chancellor declared that the universities were depending too much on the rich for support. He defended Mr. Rockefeller's business methods, and declared that the Standard Oil company magnanimously strove to buy in its competitors rather than crush them. "Like mercifully taking up a sick child and benevolently wringing its neck," was suggested to him. "Exactly," he retorted. "The analogy is a good one. Then he made a proposal that society would eventually be the judge of those who were to grow to manhood or womanhood, and would determine whether the individual had a chance enough to merit his battle for life. 'Society as it becomes more enlightened will snuff out the lives of sickly and deformed infants, to prevent their becoming a burden to the nation and to themselves. As with the cradle, so will it be with other cases. A committee of skilled physicians, I firmly believe, eventually will determine the fate of those who are sickly or whose recovery from disease is impossible. Such persons, if the physicians agree, will be mercifully put to death.' Continuing, he said, 'It is one of the saddest features of this life, this crushing of the weak by the strong in the struggle for existence. Some times I wonder, looking out over the commercial world, and viewing the wrecks thus created, that man still believes in God. And if Mr. Rockefeller has gone beyond the limit you have mentioned in his commercial struggles I do not endorse it. Mr. Rockefeller is but the head of a great corporation. It may not be his to hold him personally to account for the acts of that corporation.'

LAWYER ROBBED OF \$60,000.

Theft in a London Hotel Puzzles The Police.

Scotland Yard has no explanation of the mysterious and sensational disappearance of £12,000 (\$60,000) in Bank of England notes from the Hotel Metropole last Friday morning.

George Marshall, the solicitor of the Duke of Newcastle, to whom the money belonged, came to London on Thursday with notes to the value of £18,000 (\$90,000). That night he left the wallet with the hotel cashier.

The next morning he received the wallet from the cashier with the notes and put in his portmanteau, closed the bag without locking it and then went downstairs to be shaved. When he returned an hour later he found that the wallet had been cut open and £12,000 of the £18,000 gone. The sum of £6,000 (\$30,000) in a separate envelope had apparently been overlooked.

Mr. Marshall stated that on the night of his arrival a well-dressed man brushed against him, saying "Good evening." In the same morning he met the same man on the stairs. He suspects this man, but there is no clue to his identity.

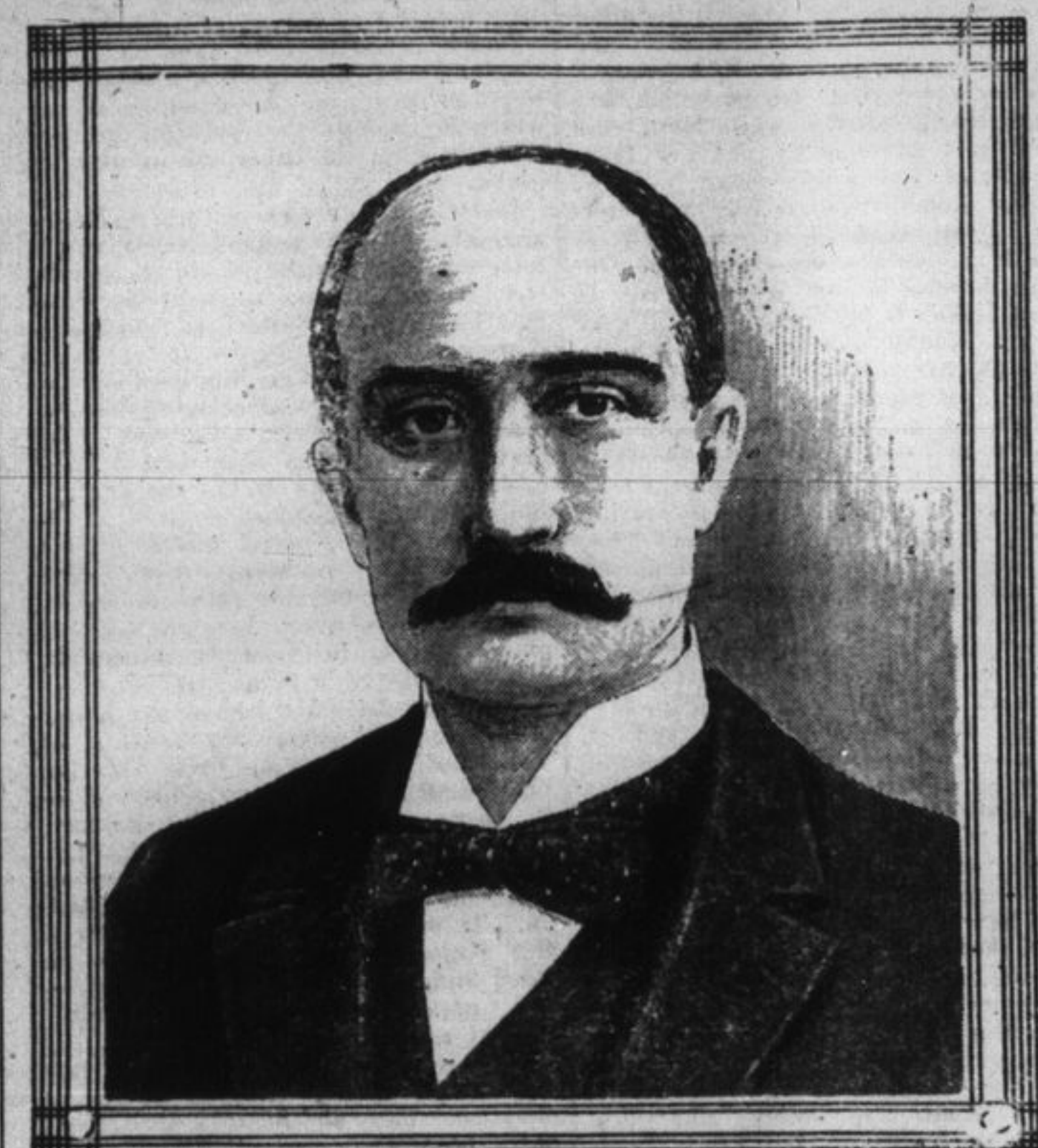
