STIRRING PATRIOTIC HYMN WHICH WE ALL LOVE.

Political Hymn of Britain So Long as the British Nation Remains Free—Reasons of the Peculiar Satisfaction Which It Engenders in British Breasts—Authorship of the Song Is a Debatable Question.

Southey said that "Rule, Britannia" would be the political hymn of this country so long as she maintains her political power. Wagner, the great composer, declared that the whole character of the British nation is expressed in the opening strains of the tune.

Unfortunately, the authorship of "Rule, Britannia" is a debated question, and debated questions are hardly fit for discussion in a column like this. Still, we want to know what can be said for one claimant or another.
