New York, July 22.—The Herald today has the following from Rochester, N.Y.: The prevailing opinion in the action which was brought about two years ago by Miss Abigail Robertson, Rochester, to restrain a manufacturing concern from the unauthorized use of her picture was written by the Chief Judge Parker, of the court of appeals, now the presidential candidate of the democratic party. Miss Robertson has written an open letter to the judge, in which she says she had read that Mrs. Parker had been compelled by the unscrupulous photographer to leave her home, and that the judge is quoted as saying: "I reserve the right to put my hands in my pockets and assume comfortable attitudes without being everlastingly afraid that I shall be snapped by some fellow with a camera." "I take this opportunity to remind you that you have no such right, as that which you assert," Miss Robertson wrote in her letter. "I have very high authority for my statement, being nothing less than a decision of the court of appeals of this state, wherein you wrote the prevailing opinion. The action was one in which I was the plaintiff. "If you will reread your opinion you will discover that you laid down very clearly therein that you had no cause of complaint against these gentlemen strictly within the rights reserved to them by your decision. In effect, you contended that the rights of one who obtains a likeness surreptitiously are superior to those of one who buys the right to use it for one purpose, but uses it for another. Naturally, the camera finds few licenses to annoy yourself and family in the manner in which you yourself suggested, at least, within the borders of this state.

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
