A BIG FIGHT

Both Fleets Engage in Night Attack.

STOUT REPULSE

OF JAPANESE, WHO LOST VERY HEAVILY.

Tokio Denies Rumour of Japanese Reverse—Port Arthur Arsenal Turning Out Ammunition—Oku Hurries Preparations.

Special to the Whig. Two messengers, who arrived on Monday night, report that the Japanese on August 4th attacked the main line of fortifications, extending over the Russian left flank. Both fleets were engaged. There was fierce fighting until early in the morning. The Japanese stormed the Russian positions, but were repeatedly repulsed, with heavy loss. Their casualties are said to be greater than they were at Wolf and Green Hills. The Russians said that more than one thousand were killed. The fight is described as the fiercest of the war. The Russians have been reinforced by the civilians remaining in the town. The damage to the fleet is unknown.

No Japanese Reverse.

London, Aug. 10.—A despatch to the Times from Tokio says that all official reports of the operations at Port Arthur are withheld, but there is no truth whatever in the Russian rumors of a Japanese reverse with heavy losses, although the fighting has been resumed.

A despatch to the Daily Telegraph from Chemo, says that a Russian engineer who arrived there on Monday, after a two days' passage from Port Arthur, states that it is believed that altogether ten Japanese boat destroyers have been sunk at Port Arthur. The arsenal is producing small arm ammunition, gun fittings, some of which enabled the nine-inch guns, which were received in an incomplete state, to be mounted.

Have Not Crossed River.

Paris, Aug. 10.—The czar has received a telegram from Gen. Kourapatkin, according to the St. Petersburg correspondent of the Echo de Paris, reporting that there has been no change in the district of concentration. The general says that the Japanese have not yet crossed the Taise river, and the Russians are still occupying the right bank. Russian troops have occupied Siao Siao, an outpost, and Gen. Kuroki has withdrawn as far as Siamatze.

Cossacks In Anshantien.

Tokio, Aug. 10.—It is reported that Cossacks are reconnoitering the Japanese advance. Thus far the Japanese have taken 1,500 prisoners, and buried 2,600 Russian dead. It is estimated that the total losses of the Russian number up to 20,000, while the invalids bring the number of troops incapacitated up to 50,000.

Oku Hurries Preparations.

Tokio, Aug. 10.—Gen. Oku is hurrying his preparations. The heat retarded the attack, but the Japanese Yang will demand the capture of the three armies. It is thought that a strong Russian force is facing Gen. Kuroki. There are no indications that the Russians intend to withdraw to Mukden. At Liao Yang there are strong defenses, which are being built up by Mukden, and Kirin and Harbin.

March From Vladivostok.

St. Petersburg, Aug. 10.—It is reported in military circles that Lieut. Gen. Linovitch is marching his troops from the direction of Vladivostok to create a diversion in the rear of Gen. Kuroki's army, with the object of relieving Gen. Kourapatkin's forces.

Outworks Probably Taken.

Tokio, Aug. 10.—A despatch from Gensan, Korea, says that two companies of Russian troops, three miles north of Gensan, engaged Japanese pickets, but were repulsed. It is reported that Field Marshal Oyama has arrived at Kiping, on his way north to attack Liao Yang. The Japanese Mail prints a summary of the Port Arthur rumors, and says that probably all the outworks have been captured, and that the Japanese army is easily in range of the main defenses. It is now a question of mounting siege guns. The indications are that the Japanese fleet co-operated vigorously with the land forces, especially in the attack on Siao Siao Ping.

Use Chinese Railway.

Mukden, Aug. 10.—The Japanese are using the Shanghai Kwan Yinkow railway for provisioning the army, and mobilizing troops for an attack on Siao Siao Ping, about thirty miles west of Mukden.
