**REPORT ROU**

**Of Japanese Left Flank and Russian Advance ONLY FIFTY LEFT OUT OF RUSSIAN RIFLE BRIGADE.**

All Exhausted, But Full of Fight — Kuropatkin Indefatigable — Victory, Keptnote of Russian Press To-day—Tokio Thinks Shangkai Victory Inconclusive.

London, Oct. 19.—A Mukden despatch bearing yesterday's date, says: "It is reported that the Russian army is advancing. News has just been received that the Japanese left flank has been driven back with heavy losses, and its retreat cut off. A Russian regiment is now being hurried to the scene in the hope of completing the roof. Another who has just returned reports that a sanguinary fight has taken place at Laithekai, fifteen miles southeast of Shangkai, to which Gen. Mitchenko retired in order to preserve communication with the Russian centre and eastern flank. The Japanese made a determined effort to cut the line of communication at this point, and did it. Out of one company of a Russian rifle brigade only fifty men were left. Two companies that had expended their ammunition, prior to the last Japanese attack, lay in the trenches until the Japanese hurled a volley of stones, charged, and had the attacking line, compelling the Japanese to flee. They were fighting to-day on both sides of the great Mandarin road. Gen. Kuropatkin is indefatigable; personally directing the forward operations. Nothing has been taken since the morning of the 17th. The Japanese are in a quiet smile under all circumstances. The last Japanese defenders of Lone Tree Hill, two artillery officers, refused quarter, and died fighting in their swords beside their guns. A despatch from Fidyatun, six miles east of Shangkai, to-day, says fighting still continues, and that the front line is heavily riddled with shells. Every one is terribly exhausted, but full of life.

London, Oct. 19.—Neither the official nor unofficial dispatches received here, show whether the Russians are really succeeding in reversing the verdict of the last ten days' fighting. The Russian newspaper reports representing the czar's troops as having achieved material successes, are not confirmed officially. According to today's despatches, Field Marshal Dyann's reference in his report to Russian reinforcements, is more emphatically worded than the summary given out by the Japanese legation.

**Both Sides Use Balloons.**

London, Oct. 19.—Little is heard from Port Arthur. It is stated in Chicago, that the Japanese are trying to send Chinese messengers to inform the garrison of Gen. Kuropatkin's despatch. The Japanese are still shelling the fortress. They greatly hope to reduce it before winter, so that they can use it as a base. Both sides are using balloons to direct their artillery fire.

**Strike Threatened.**

Montreal, Oct. 19.—A strike of building laborers is threatened in this city and a meeting will be held, to-night, of the union, to settle the matter. There was trouble in the building labor market in September, a year ago, when some eighty-nine contractors agreed to pay the pick and shovel men seventeen cents per hour, and twenty cents for hod carriers. Peter Loyal, one of the largest contractors in the Dominion and liberal candidate in St. Antoine division for parliament, in this city, stood out for the open labor market and no favors to union men. He was backed up by a number of other contractors and ever since has maintained that stand. The union claims he is trying to rush the organizations and declares that it will fight the matter to a finish now. If a strike is ordered some large buildings in course of construction will be held up at a bad time of year.

Over twenty persons were injured in the disturbance, some of them being seriously hurt.

**A Wife Deserts.**

London, Ont., Oct. 19.—Alfred Henry Taylor, a wife-deserter, has been sentenced to twenty-nine months' imprisonment at Kingston penitentiary. He had been married for thirteen years. Four years ago Taylor left his wife, and was found in Detroit, living with a London woman, his wife and children being on the verge of starvation.

**Farmer's Wife Dead.**

Bridgeton, N.J., Oct. 19.—Mrs. F. Rasinger, wife of a farmer living near here, was found dead in her home with a gunshot wound in her body near the heart. Frank Rasinger, the husband, says he found the body on the floor upon returning from the barn. A shotgun was found near the body.

**Ten Years In Prison.**

Davenport, Ia., Oct. 19.—Former Mayor F. Smith, of this city, son of Samuel Francis Smith, author of "My Country, 'Tis of Thee," was sentenced to ten years' imprisonment for embezzling \$120,000 from estates for which he was trustee.

**THE JURY'S VERDICT.**

A Conductor Stands Accused Of Manslaughter.

Preston, Ont., Oct. 19.—As the result of the coroner's inquest of Miss Annie Hemlock, of Hespeler, who lost her life in the collision which took place here, on Monday morning, between an electric car and a coal car, which with three others was being switched by a freight motor, Conductor Meyers, Preston, who has in charge of the motor, is under arrest on a charge of manslaughter. The jury found that the collision was due to carelessness on the part of the conductor and the crew of the motor.
