WAITER'S TIPS. THE "POOLING" OF THESE IS SUGGESTED. Proprietors of London Restaurants Say Public Is To Blame For Tipping.

London, Nov. 14.—The question of tips has been raised at last in a form which may definitely influence public opinion against the system. In the city hall there is the resolution, in Westminster county court on Thursday, that in many cases tips to waiters and their way into the pockets of proprietors of hotels and restaurants, and on the other hand, the public, are to be considered.

It is argued that the public alone are responsible for the tipping system and as an instance of how hard it is to suppress the habit the experience of the "pooling" of these is significant. Many patrons of the cafe are unable to resist the instinctive desire to reward the waiter's attention to their needs. Despite the announcement that all gratuities will be appropriated by the management, nearly 45 was given in tips during the first week.

Inquiries made yesterday show that customers at some popular resorts provide highly placed servants with the position of all proportion to the positions which they occupy. Down in Sussex there lives a gentleman whose generosity and public spirit have led him to the countryside. He gives large shooting parties, and owns a fine motor car. His horses are all thoroughbreds. He is one of the best known restaurantiers in Regent street seven or eight years ago after the death of the proprietor.

"The pooling" system is the one most generally adopted, and seems to be the fairest method. "Some waiters may have five customers at their tables," explained Mr. Prager, "and it is only right that the tips should be collected and afterwards divided, consideration being given to a man's position and length of service."

TORE UP BRITISH FLAG. Will Unveil Monument To "Manchester Martyrs."



O'DONOVAN ROSSA. New York, Nov. 15.—O'Donovan Rossa, "seventy-four years old and as big a rebel as ever," to use his own words, tore a British flag to shreds just before he sailed, Saturday, for the Ettrian for Ireland, where, in his native town of Skibbereen, he will unveil a monument to the "Manchester Martyrs" hanged November 23rd, 1847, for the murder of a policeman while rescuing Fenian prisoners from jail.

At a moment later, somebody handed Rossa a flag, which, without notice, he waved above his head. It was a Union Jack. The flag from the coat of arms of the old man to make the discovery. He tore the emblem to shreds, while his friends cheered the martyrs' cause.

Nan Patterson On Trial. Special to the Whig.
