WERE CHASED.

TERRIBLE STORY OF SHIP-
WRECKED CREW.

Without Food, Water, Compass
or Sails In An Open Boat
Eleven Days — Wild Story
Told By a Shipwrecked Crew.

San Francisco, Cal., Dec. 27.—A voyage of 200 miles by boat, almost destitute of provisions and water, pursued by a horde of giant sharks that threatened momentarily, day and night to capsize the craft and devour its occupants, was the experience of Captain Sam Harris and four South Sea Islanders who composed the crew of the little trading schooner Victor wrecked on Apataki Island, on November 30th. Apataki, is 200 miles from Papeete, the Port of Tahiti. This is a tale of the sea brought by the liner Mariposa, just arrived, which left Papeete on the day Captain Harris and his men landed there, emaciated and nearly crazed, but still alive.

The Victor ended her career by stranding the boat and the shipwrecked crew had time to put off the boat for their long voyage, made with one compass and no sail, with one day's provisions on board and half a dozen coconuts. The milk from the latter was all they had to drink during the eleven days it took to reach Papeete.
