### A Racy Review For Merchants, Traders And Farmers.

Montreal, Jan. 27.—The markets for country produce were dull, this week. There appears to be a temporary lull in every line and dealers are taking their holidays, whenever possible. The demand for butter seems to have fallen off considerably during the past week and at the present there is very little changing hands. Receipts continue very light, much less than consumption, so that stocks are gradually increasing and the result is that holders are asking firm prices. Dairy rolls have been firm during the past week and dealers have had some little difficulty in obtaining sufficient. The manufacture of these pieces of leather is a regular business in France.
