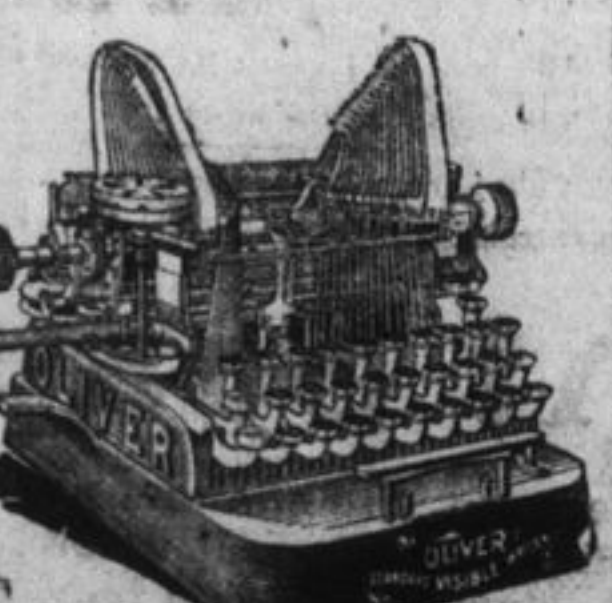

### BIBLE REVISION

#### THE TWENTIETH CENTURY VERSION HAS BIG SALE.

Promoter is Samuel Lloyd-Bishop of Durham Approves—Specimens of Some of the Changes Made.

London, Feb. 15.—The demand for new versions of the Scriptures appears to be almost insatiable. At a time when one new version is being published, "The Twentieth Century" has attained the extraordinary sale of 500,000 copies. Another version has been completed for publication on both sides of the Atlantic. The title of the new work, "The Corrected English New Testament," does not convey the full extent of the task which its editors have set themselves. They claim that the Scriptures now appear in the "King's English," for the first time.

Reading in mind that the New Testament writings have to religious writers a documentary as well as literary aspect their aim has been to give throughout a close translation. But they decline themselves to take greater pains than their predecessors working on similar lines to produce a work that shall be essentially English and not a translation of a translation. The work is put forward in a simple and unequivocal meaning, but also in its literary form as attractive as possible to the mass of readers. The promoter and general editor of the work is Samuel Lloyd, a life governor of the British and Foreign Bible Society. His association with the promotion of Bible knowledge has been life-long. More than fifty years ago he translated the Bible into Spanish, and in 1860 he translated the Bible into English. He has been in the forefront of the movement for the revision of the Bible.

A Bishop Approves. The work has won the approval of so high an authority as the Bishop of Durham, who has written a preface to it in which he says it is a remedy in countless instances the serious lack of English felicity of the revised version.

A tentative edition of the present work was prepared some time ago by Canon Girdleston, and circulated among scholars, some twenty or thirty of whom have voluntarily contributed suggestions. In the revision Mr. Lloyd has had the assistance of the Rev. E. E. Cunningham and Mr. W. B. Farbuty, the latter of whom gave out this statement: "We have not striven after purely literary graces, and any literary merit will, of course, have to be credited first to the original, but we have studied euphony and while we have always in mind the plain man and woman we have endeavored never to be 'indulgent.' We hope we have produced a translation which may be read in church without shocking the most devout worshipper and without sending anyone to sleep—one which may be read at home without any unnecessary mystification."

Policy Carried Out. "It is a curious fact that a great many of the texts expressing popular opinions which are instances of the accuracy of the authorized version, has pained us to alter them, but truth is greater than sentiment. GEORGE SUTHERLAND. Salt Lake City, Utah, Feb. 18.—George Sutherland, recently elected to the United States senate by the unanimous vote of the republican members of the Utah legislature, is a lawyer of great ability, and one of the most popular men in his home state.
