## BRITAIN WINS

### AFTER ALL RUSSIANS BADLY BEATEN.

Admiral Who Saw Things That Were Not There Let Down Easy by Commissioners. Paris, Feb. 25.—The decision of the international commission of inquiry into the North Sea incident was published this afternoon.

The decision says the delay of the Russian transport Kamschatka following the break down of her machinery was perhaps the cause of the incident. The commission of the Kamschatka signalled to Admiral Rojestvensky during the evening that he had been attacked by torpedo.

The British Foreign Office. London, Feb. 27.—The foreign office received the findings of the North Sea commission on Sunday morning, but declined to give out any official expression of opinion thereon. An official said to the Associated Press: "The finding of the commission is final. We therefore are satisfied and it would be bad taste for us to express dissatisfaction."

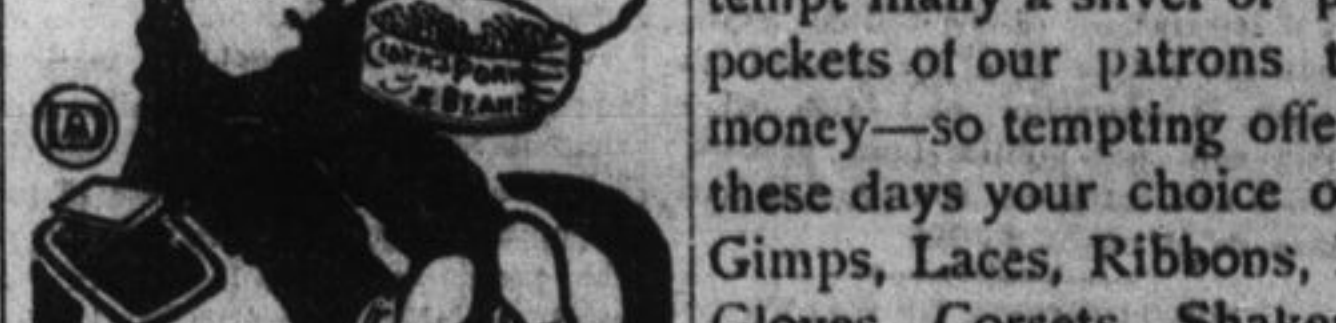
