

STREET CARS TO STOP

After March 6th Unless Cheap Power Is Given For Six Months --- Railway Steadily Losing Money---To Retain It The City Must Come to Its Aid.

Unless the city comes immediately to the aid of the Street Railway Company, there will be no cars after March 6th. That was the announcement made by W. F. Nickle, president of the bondholders, to the city council last night.
