It is announced that the Manitoba government is investigating the operations of the Sifton machine in the last election.

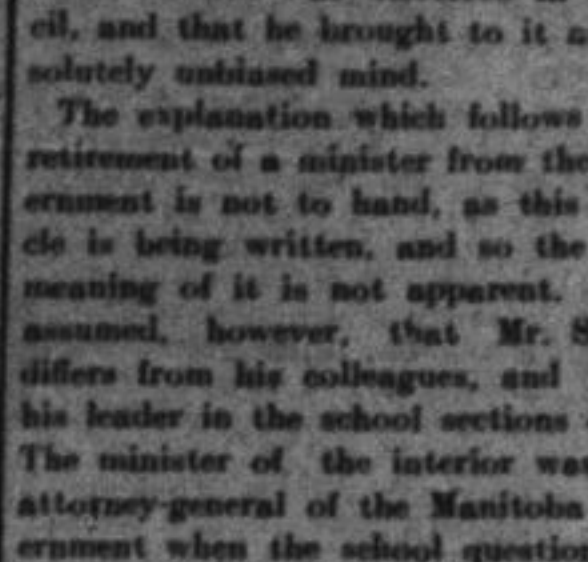
The resignation of Hon. Mr. Sifton from the government is an unexpected event. Honor had it that he was concerned about the autonomy bill, and especially about its school amendments.
