AGRICULTURAL. Production And Care Of Milk In

The Ontario Agricultural College bulletin regrets that Canadian dairymen have leasened production of winter milk, consequently a shortage. Not many can avail themselves of the good prices now offered for dairy products, and especially for fine butter. The essentials for economical production are:

It has 1,-721,541 milch cows, while Iowa, second in rank, has 1,335,832. Formerly Pennsylvania was third, but Wisconsin has passed the Keystone state.

New York still has a million sheep, but it long ago gave up its pre-eminence in sheep raising. Montana is the first sheep state, with 5,638,967, and Wyoming second, with 3,267,887. In New York sheep are raised more for their mutten than their wool, In horses New York stands fifth. Texas
