(Continued from page 2) battle, but in a partisan town where he is called together in large numbers he is not a moral gain to the community; at least that has been the experience of most places. Indeed any large body of men without the ties of home and family will hardly be on the same level in regard to moral standards as citizens who have, as Bacon says, given hostages to fortune in the shape of wives and children. There are just a few more suggestions I wish to make under this head of my talk. As reverence is really the foundation stone of morals and religion, I think it is well to have our school children were taught to have greater respect for their elders and for those in authority over them. The slipping of the civility of the present day is very noticeable, and it is a very serious fault for it leads to others far more serious. It is to our churches, however, that we look more especially for moral and religious training and we can safely say that in Kingston they are in sufficient number and sufficiently strong to do what is required of them.

Electoral Corruption. The Citizens' League has given some attention to the question of the prevention of bribery and corruption in their character, have been passed by both Dominion and local houses on this subject, but to very little effect if we may judge by recent election contests. Public opinion seems not to be trained up to the mark required for bringing offenders to justice. The offence of bribery is looked upon too lightly by the average citizen and will not be a general toning up of public opinion that this will be effectively suppressed.

No Canvassing and Compulsory Voting. There are two things which, however, if carried out would have marked effect in preventing bribery and corruption in elections, one is to make it an offence to canvass a voter personally, the other, to make voting compulsory. An election campaign could surely be carried on without requiring the candidate to visit every voter, but a general toning up of public opinion that this will be effectively suppressed.
