AN ARMISTICE Has Been Asked by Kuro-patkin, Reports Say. RUSSIANS FLEE AT POINT OF JAPANESE BAYONETS. Over 200,000 Russians Surrounded—Their Centre Annihilated—English Critics Say Russians Are Doomed—Are Terribly Exhausted, and Without Food.

MUKDEN TAKEN. Tokyo, March 10.—The Japanese troops occupied Mukden, at ten o'clock, this (Friday) morning. Yinkow, March 10.—Mukden fell at ten o'clock, this morning. The Russians are panic-stricken and thousands of prisoners and enormous quantities of stores and guns have been captured.

Wants Car to Command. Berlin, March 10.—Newspapers, here state on the authority of St. Petersburg, correspondents, that the war party is not only not discouraged by the heavy Russian reverses, but is trying to arrange for the dispatch to the war of another army of 400,000 men, and that the supporters of the czar are trying to persuade the czar to take command, personally, of this army.

Kuropatkin Bitterly Criticized. London, March 10.—Gen. Kuropatkin is bitterly criticized for poor tactics and strategy, but it is hoped he will succeed in bringing his army north. Admiral Rojstvensky has gone to Jibuti, to meet Admiral Niebovoff's division, and colliers which are shortly leaving Port Said.

Tokio Celebrates Victory. Tokyo, March 9.—(Noon).—Although the actual extent of the success gained by Field Marshal Oyama's army is unknown, Tokio is already celebrating the victory. An official announcement of the results of Field Marshal Oyama's pursuit of the Russians is expected here later to-day.

MARTIN GONE. He Ended His Days On The Scaffold. FOR THE MURDER OF HIS OWN CHILD BY DROWNING IT. An Execution at Toronto Jail This Morning—Alexander Martin Was the Offender Against Law—A Story of His Crime.

Special to the Whig. Toronto, March 10.—Alexander Martin was hanged, this morning, for the murder of his infant child on August 3rd last. He died protesting his innocence. To Sheriff Mowat he said: 'Sir, I just wish to say you are hanging an innocent man.'

The Very Latest News Cull'd From All Over The World. Hunger and the grippe are causing terrible suffering at St. Pierre, N.E. Gen. Boisard, former president of Hayti, is dead at Port au Prince.

Hotly Pursued. Tokyo, March 10.—Advices from Manchurian headquarters state that in the neighbourhood of Tala our forces, on Thursday, completely disclosed the enemy, whom they are now pursuing. Our forces in the vicinity of Manchunant continue in hot pursuit of the enemy towards Fushun.

Horror at Mukden. London, March 10.—The correspondent at Tokio, of the Daily Telegraph says on official authority, that millions of dollars worth of stores at Mukden, have been destroyed or abandoned in the last forty-eight hours.

Intense Jubilation. Tokyo, March 10.—The most intense jubilation prevails here over the fall of Mukden. There is a great difference of opinion here as to whether the great Japanese victory will mean peace. Those most capable of expressing an opinion decline to commit themselves, saying that everything depends on the czar, and that it is impossible to say how he will take such an overwhelming defeat.

Little Consolation Offered. St. Petersburg, March 10. (1 p.m.)—The extent of the disaster to Gen. Kuropatkin's army is, as yet, unknown here, but the public believes that Field Marshal Oyama has succeeded in closing the iron ring around at least a large portion of the army.

Who the Assassin Has Proved to Be. Paris, March 10.—The St. Petersburg correspondent of Petit Journal, says the assassin of the Grand Duke Sergius has been found to be a member of a princely family.

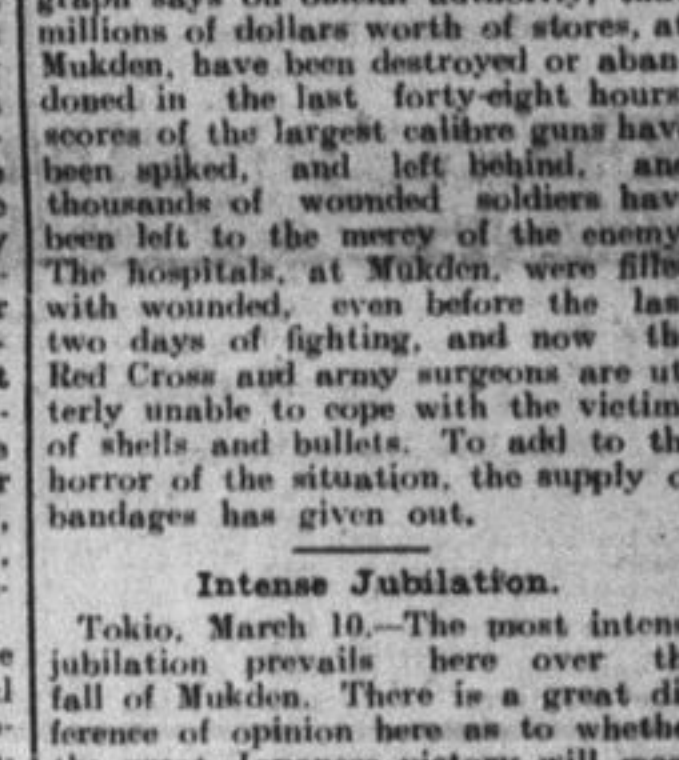
