LECTURE ON JAPAN

DELIVERED BY: EV. EBER CRUMMY.

In Brock Street Methodist Church last evening, The Message of Christendom to Japan, and That of Japan to Christendom.

The audience that assembled in Brock Street Methodist church last night, to hear Rev. Eber Crummy's lecture on Japan's contribution to civilization, was not only unusually good in point of numbers, but presented a very high average of intelligence. Colonel Twitchell, United States consul, occupied the chair, and introduced the lecturer in a short and appropriate address. He said that the citizens of Kingston were especially fortunate at the present juncture, when all eyes were turned toward the east, in having in their midst one who not only lived for years in Japan, but was especially equipped as an observer.

Mr. Crummy called attention, in commencing his lecture, to the character of the literature which introduced Japan to the western public. This had to be discounted very largely in order to reach the truth. He also pointed out that it was difficult to find a standard that would measure civilization so as to give us any claim to a civilization superior of the Japanese. The lecturer then pointed out that the contribution of the Japanese to civilization was really what they themselves as a nation were and that this involved a study of the characteristics. He approached the country as a stranger would, and called attention to their indifference to time as a characteristic which held the key of the problem. To trace this to its source was also to discover the source from which came the great national characteristics, the social or tribal consciousness as distinguished from the individual. This would explain their individual indifference to death on the battlefield.

The characteristics were then followed through the national social organizations of the tribe or family and illustrated by the special peculiarity of loyalty to masters. The story of the forty-seven ronins was told to illustrate this. The lecturer's conclusion was that individuality was the message of Christendom to Japan, and the tribal or social consciousness, the contribution of Japan to Europe and America. The individual must realize itself in its higher reaches not in isolation, but in social relationships, and Japan held before the European world not a higher type, but one that would serve as a suggestion of the higher development toward which it must yet advance.
