SERMONS PREACHED BY REV. DR. KIRKPATRICK OF CAMBRIDGE.

A Large Audience Heard His Discourse on the Book of Job, in Convocation Hall—His Sermon in St. George's Last Evening.

In old Convocation hall yesterday afternoon, Rev. Dr. Kirkpatrick, pastor of Selwyn College, Cambridge, preached to an extremely large congregation of people. His subject was the book of Job, and his text was Job xxiii, 3, and Job xl, 5.

The preacher dealt with the object and lessons, past and present, of the book of Job. The ancient Israelites only knew this world as the place of God's dealing with men, the early theory which prevailed being that of prompt retribution.
