Injuring Our Credit. Mr. Mathieson's pessimism, in the legislature and as the spokesman of the government, will injure the credit of the province.

Mr. Harcourt had occasion to refer to this subject, briefly, in replying to Mr. Mathieson's budget speech. The treasurer had ruthlessly wiped out certain assets, as of no consequence, as not correctly classified by the late liberal government.

"At the time the Niagara acts were passed," said Mr. Harcourt, "capitalists were investing in what was an experiment, and even Lord Kelvin considered the transmission of power to Toronto a dream.

Col. Mathieson stated that these had been put among the indirect liabilities, and a note added showing the estimated revenue. "But a very direct way of injuring the credit of the province," retorted Mr. Harcourt.

As to the Temiskaming railway bonds Mr. Harcourt showed the circumstances that had operated against the sale of them. The Japanese war crisis created such a depression in the stock market as had rarely been seen.

Mr. Harcourt added a word of information and a word of advice. He pointed out that Mr. Mathieson had not calculated the interest on the bonds aright, and he counselled the government against any misrepresentation of the provincial finances.

Fulfilling A Promise. It is charged against the Ross government that it promised the Ottawa University in 1904, after the fire, a grant of \$10,000, towards rebuilding, but did not pay it over.

The Street Railway Co., Toronto, has been declared by the court to be liable for negligence as to the condition of the track and operation of the cars.

The Mail repeats Mr. Hanna's hobo talk about the liquor business being conducted "irrespective of party leanings."

The electors in Edmonton, regardless of party, are tendering Mr. Oliver their support.

Who Are The Bosses?

One gathered the impression, from the remarks of Mr. Whitney while he was leader of the opposition and leader of the government, that under conservative rule there would be a non-political enforcement of the license law.

Mr. Hanna, the provincial secretary, when jollied about the premier's attitude and his own, early in the game of government, repeated that the law would be enforced regardless of politics and regardless of consequences.

The sincerity of the government is being demonstrated by its performance in Essex and Kingston. In each place the government made an appointment, ostensibly on its merits, and in each case there was a howl from the party, and the appointment was annulled.

This evidence is being supplied that the government may have had good intentions, but they have been overruled. The license department will be run on party lines, and on no other lines.

Notice is thereby given to the government to keep hands off. In future it will hesitate about acting upon public appointments. The bosses are not in the government and they are not willing to abdicate their functions.

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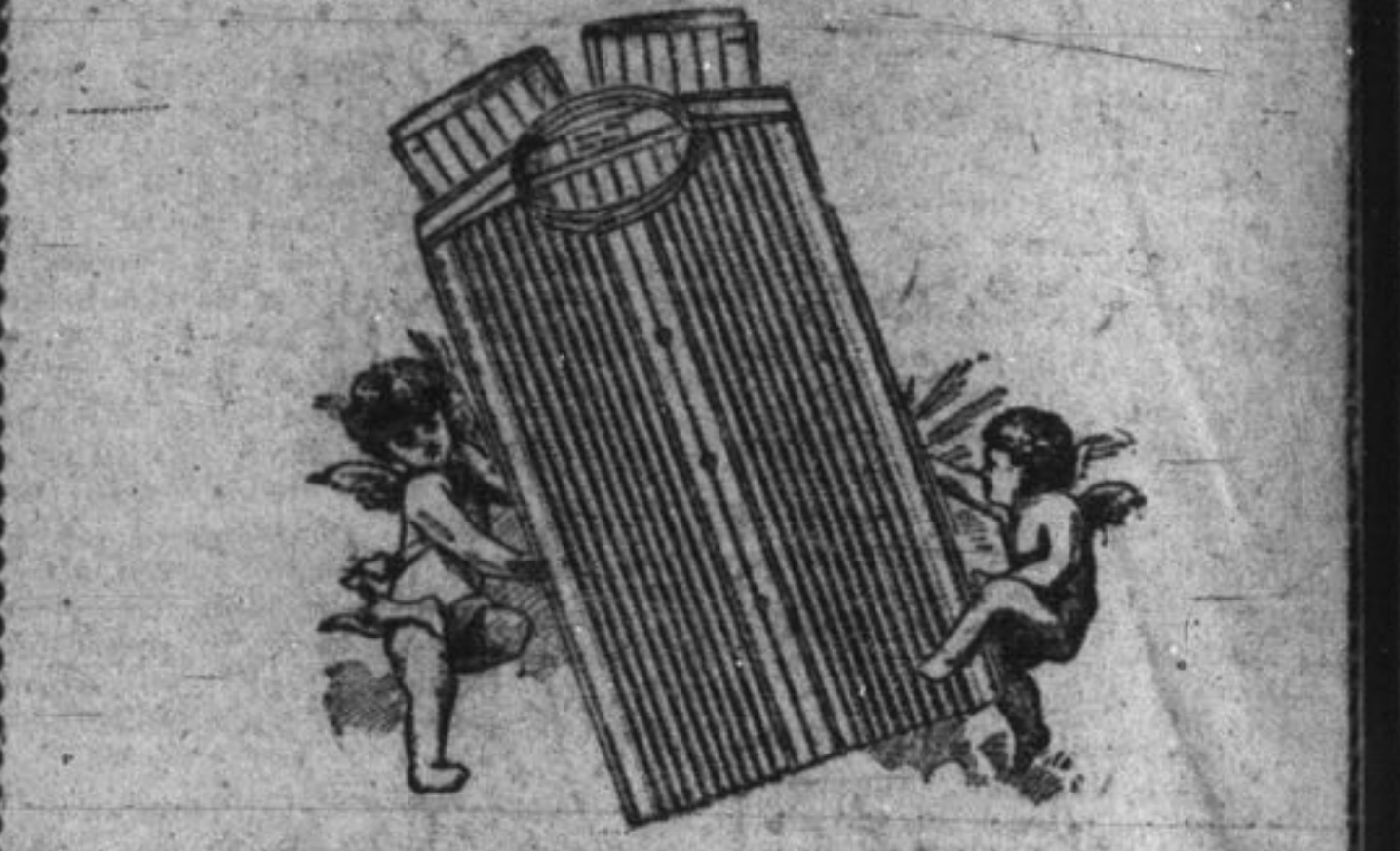
