



HOMESTEAD REGULATIONS Thy even numbered section of Dominion Lands in Manitoba or the North-We Territories, excepting 8 and 26, which has not been homesteaded, or reserved to provide wood lots for settlers, or for other purposes, may be homesteaded upon by any person who is the sole head of afamily, or any male over 18 years of age to the extent of one-quarter section of 160 acres, more or

Entry may be made personally at the local land office for the which the land to be taken is situated, or if the homestender desires he may, on application to the Minister of the Interior, Ottawa, the Commissioner of Immigration, Winnipeg, or the Local Agent for the District in which the land is

(1) At lease six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in ear during the term of three years. It is the practice of the Department to requ stock; and 20 head of cattle, to be actually his own property, with building
