HOW TO GROW RASPBERRIES

An Agricultural College Expert Ont. Gives a Few Pointers. This berry succeeds best on light

warm soil. The red varieties are propagated by suckers that come up from the roots of the old plants, the black caps by tips. The young canes grow up, turn over and the points take root in the soil usually in Au gust or September. In most sections the reds are cultivated in rows six to eight feet apart and the plants two and one-half feet apart in the, row Then let the suckers fill up between to form a solid row.

The blacks are usually planted hills four or five feet apart eac way. In order to get a big crop large berries it is necessary to give liberal application of manure good clean cultivation. I found of late years that I can keep up the size of my berries much better by cultivating right through the picking season. 




