Does Germany Want To Provoke France. IT LOOKS THAT WAY

FRANCE IS GETTING READY TO ACT.

Every Concession France Offers is Met With Fresh Demands—The Aggression is Aimed Quite as Much Against Britain as Towards France.

The French government is almost convinced that it is Germany's deliberate intention to provoke war and is making every preparation to resist attack.

Lord Lansdowne, the British Foreign Secretary, has been charged with furnishing information to the Russian government regarding Japanese war plans.

Baron Nathaniel de Rothschild, promoter of the Ando, of the Austro-branch of the firm, which died on June 13th, left the sum of \$4,000,000 to be distributed for various charitable purposes.
