Special Correspondence Letter, No. 1,464. New York, June 16.—Two great events have occurred in the week just passed which have brought New York into prominence throughout the civilized world.

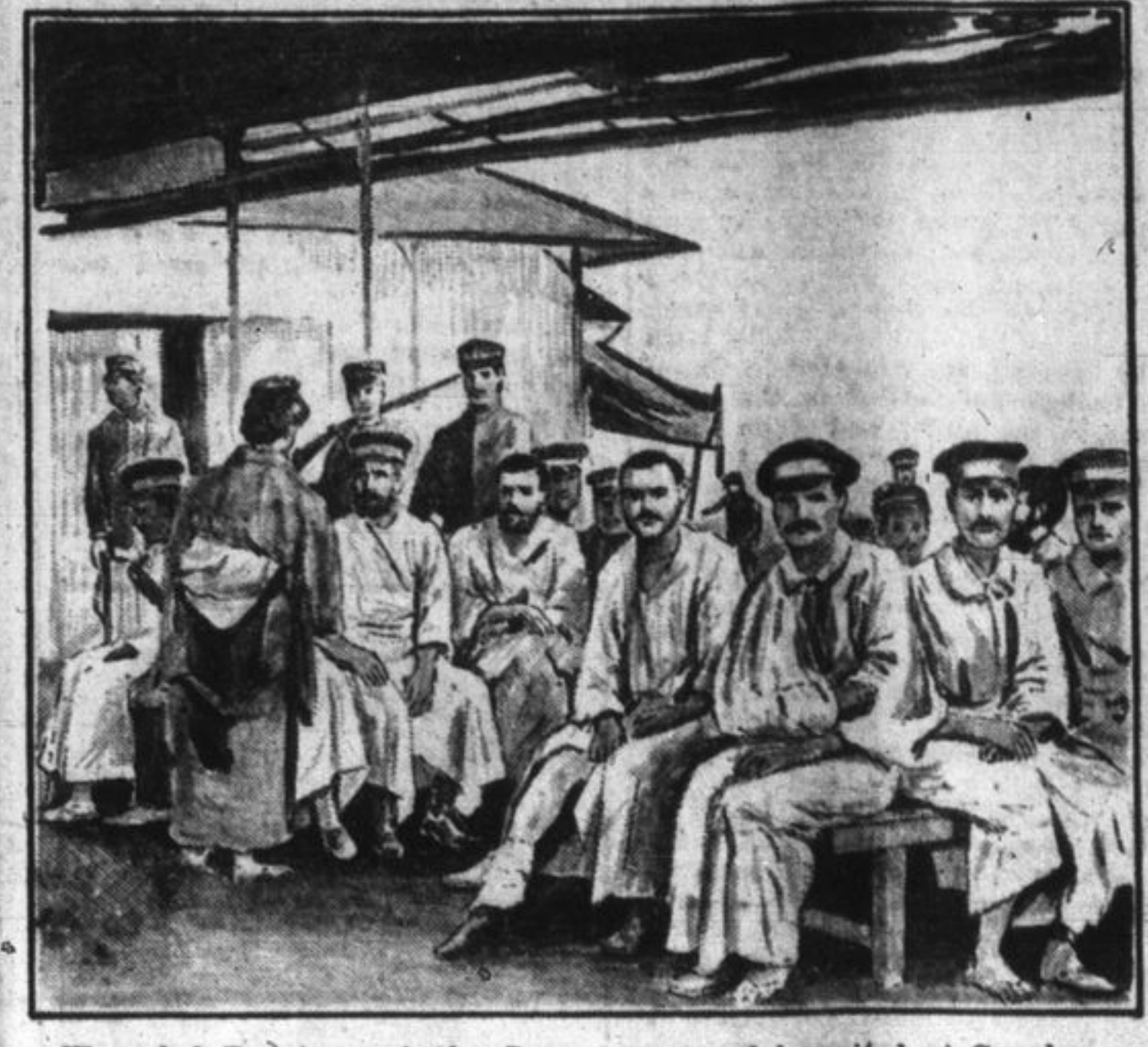
The business of the Equitable Life Insurance Company, which has kept the financial world on the edge for many months, has been practically settled. The difficult point in the settlement lay in the fact, that the multi-millionaires who received high salaries and who absolutely held in their power the enormous sum of four hundred and seventy-five millions of dollars were not willing to part with the holdings that gave them unlimited power. It was recognized from the first that if peace, with justice, was ever to come, it could only be accomplished by inducing the capitalists to part with their holdings for a price, for as long as some members of the board of trustees held the majority of the stock, the chances of peace were hopeless.

"JOB" ON THE STAGE

THE BIBLICAL BOOK TO BE DRAMATIZED.

And Produced in Detroit—Ministers Would Take the Part of Actors—A Unique Innovation.

Detroit, June 16.—Ministers taking the part of actors would be a decidedly unique innovation in the annals of Detroit stages, but it is what Marcellus La Blanche proposes to do should he be unable to secure such actors as will give his dramatization of the book of Job the proper atmosphere when it is presented within the same hall.

Mr. La Blanche has been working on the dramatization of this play for several years, and has just brought it to that state of perfection where he feels satisfied to have it presented to the public.

The drama consists of four tableaux and two acts. The first tableau will be the feast; the second, Job and his wife; the third, Job's friends deserting him; and the fourth, Job conquering with a choir singing "The Lord Giveth and the Lord Taketh Away."

Mr. La Blanche will enact the part of God and propose to surround the drama with all the dignity and historical accuracy of the Bible in this production, following carefully the text, but in dialogue form.

ST. PAUL WAS RIGHT. Hopes Women Won't Get the Franchise.

New York, June 15.—Cardinal Gibbons delivered an address to the graduates of Mount St. Agnes at the commencement exercises, says a Baltimore special to the Sun. In his address he said: "Woman to-day is the peer of her husband, not the slave of his caprice and passion. But because you are equal in quality, it does not mean you should perform the same functions. Some women are not satisfied with their own power. They want to invade the man's privileges, and they want to vote. I trust they will never get the authority to do that, for when woman mingles in political life, she loses her freshness."

"You cannot vote, but you can make your men vote to please you, and you cannot preach. Some of these women get angry with St. Paul, and call him an old fogey and an old bachelor, but he was right. You can preach in your home for the best teacher, is the good, pious, Christian mother."
