# FOR ICE RACING AN ASSOCIATION HAS BEEN FORMED.

Kingston's Dates Are February 8th and 9th—General Sporting Notes From Many Quarters.

D. C. Dick won the Austin trophy at the Lambton Golf and Country Club by defeating W. K. Ross in the final by one up. Charles Elwood did not do as well as the rest of the horses in the Kirkwood field string this year so he was rested up for the falling meeting.
