TO STOP THE ISSUE

A LAWYER IN NAPANEE TO TAKE PROCEEDINGS.

To Quash the Recent By-Law Passed—Shots Fired By One Man at Another—Personal Notes.

Napanee, Ont., Aug. 8.—One of the leading lawyers in town has received instructions to take proceedings to quash the by-law authorizing the issuing of debentures for the installing of a municipal electric plant in Napanee, and has notified the council to that effect, not to issue any debentures until the matter has been adjudicated upon.

On Saturday last, quite a lot of excitement was caused by the report that Samuel Howard had fired three shots from a rifle, at Paul Peterson. One of the shots took effect in Peterson's arm, but not very serious injury was caused. Howard was arrested and remanded to jail for a week. Later he was bailed out to appear on Saturday next, for the shooting was of a private character.

The electrical storm of Sunday afternoon was one of the worst in some years. For over an hour thunder and lightning rent the air and from the north of thunder followed by lightning, in such rapid succession, it was feared that considerable damage would be reported later. Yesterday it was learned that Mr. Wiggins, living about two miles west of the town, had his barn burned. PRINCE EDWARD OLD BOYS'.

Over 500 of Them Visiting Their Former Homes.

Pictou, Aug. 7.—Five hundred Old Boys and Girls took possession of the county on Saturday. 300 of the number completing the journey to Pictou from Toronto. In town very little "fuss" was made over their arrival, as in former years. The Citizens' band played at the station when the train came in. The main thoroughfares of the town were prettily decorated with appropriate mottoes, flags and bunting. The majority of the home-comers returned to Toronto this afternoon, but a goodly number remained for a longer holiday. The death occurred, Sunday, of Henry Bartholomew, at the advanced age of ninety-two years. The steamer Alexandria had 140 through passengers to Quebec to-day.

"VOLCANO-BORN" PROPHECY

Many Peasant Girls Entrapped by Scoundrel.

Berlin, Aug. 8.—An extraordinary trial, concluded in Volodga, sheds a glaring light on the extraordinary administration of justice in the czar's dominions. The presiding judge is reported by the local press to have explained that immorality is not a punishable offence, but that disloyalty to the czar called for the very heaviest punishment.

As a result, Andrei Liesnikoff, an aged peasant, was sentenced last week to sixty-five years' imprisonment. His case had lasted nearly a year, and no fewer than 320 female witnesses testified during the trial. Evidence of the most extraordinary credibility among the Volodga peasantry was given, the story told saving more of the 15th, than the 20th century. For years, it was proved, Liesnikoff had been in the habit of masquerading among the simple moujiks as a Heaven-sent prophet. Born, he said, spontaneously of a volcano, he had been sent into the world to reveal to the women of the village, in which he happened to be at the time, that one of their number was destined to be the mother of the present czar's successor on the throne. Nicholas II., he affirmed, would probably never have a son, and, if he did, that son would die before twelve months had passed. Uncredited among his people, the present czar would in the year 1905, adopt a peasant boy, of which he (Liesnikoff) was fated to be the father. It was proved at the trial that more than 200 peasant girls had been entrapped by this extraordinary scoundrel.

NEWS OF THE WORLD

OCCURRENCES RECOUNTED IN BRIEF FORM.

Matters That Interest Everybody
—Notes From All Over—Little Of Everything Easily Read And Remembered.

Premier Balfour says no invitations have been sent out for a colonial conference.

Alexander Bell, father of Professor Alexander Graham Bell, died at Washington.

A new Japanese torpedo boat destroyer, the Yavoi, was launched at Yokosuka Island.

The United States grain crops are expected to exceed those of any other year in quantity and value.

Doty Webb, a London ball player, was hit on the head by a pitched ball and died a few hours afterwards.

The 74th Regiment of Buffalo, will visit Toronto, on September 1st, as guests of the Queen's Own Rifles.

The militia department expect that the transfer of the Halifax fortress to the Canadian authorities will take place on September 15th.

Dr. Rankine, Dawson, son of the late principal of McGill University, has been chosen as the liberal unionist candidate for East Edinburgh.

A bill to take place at the parliament buildings, Quebec, in honor of the visit of H. R. H. Prince Louis of Battenberg, and officers of the cruiser squadron.

On Saghalien Island, the Russian prisoners of war, forty thousand in all, are being transferred to Japan. The political prisoners will probably be returned to Russia.

The crops on the south shore from Levis east to Gaspere, are suffering from want of rain. The hay and oats are very poor, and it is feared that the root crops will also suffer.

In the case of the "mized sailing schooner Agnes G. Donahue, satisfactory arrangements have been completed between the Canadian authorities and the Uruguayan government.

An upset on St. Hyacinthe river, at the city of that name, Misses Anna and Laura Phaneuf, aged seventeen and thirteen, were drowned, and Almousa, aged nine, was rescued as well as Mr. Sicotte, in charge of the craft.

Senor Jose Miguel Gomez, mayor of Santa Clara, province of Cuba, and candidate for the presidency of the island, has given out an interview full of defiance to the Palma government and declares that Cuba is a powder mine with the fuse half-burned.

United States Secretary Root, now in Newfoundland, will hold a conference with the colonial ministry respecting the Bond-Hay treaty with the view of effecting a compromise which will prevent the enforcement of the bill act and grant the colony the advantage of the American fish markets.

The reactionaries of the commission at Peterhof, made strong efforts to secure the rejection or alteration of two important provisions of the project, but were prevented by the czar and grand dukes, who showed themselves more anxious for reform than any other members of the commission.

While bathing alone in the waters of Phillips Beach, Mass., Dr. Robert Fowler Beattie, Brockline, whose romantic wedding, a year ago, to Miss Sarah Whittmore, Duggett, former state regent of the Daughters of the Revolution, is the talk of society, was overcome by heart failure this morning and drowned. The body was recovered.
