### NOTES ON PLAYS, PLAYERS AND PLAYHOUSES.

Louis James To Revive "Virginius"-Tendency Towards Revival of Artistic Stock Companies in New York.

Ada Rehan will be seen in "Capt. Brassbound's Conversion," by George Bernard Shaw this season.

Uggs Netherlands makes her first appearance this season in the United States in Washington on October 23rd.

George Ade's newest comedy, "The Bad Samaritan," will open the Garden Theatre, New York, September 11th.

Blanche Walsh will open her season in her last year's success, "A Woman in the Case," at Cincinnati's Labor Day.

E. S. Willard will appear at the Toronto Princess theatre, Monday, October 23rd, for a two weeks engagement.

### A PRETTY SCENE IN "SAN TOY."

At The Grand, on Wednesday, Aug. 30th.

Dusa has cancelled her American engagement. This is a keen disappointment for the lovers of the highest dramatic art.

Louis James will devote his forty-first year as an actor to a mammoth revival of that Roman classic in which he has been so ideally identified, "Virginius."

The opening of Daly's theatre, New York, is set for August 21st. Then Richard May will appear in "The Catch of the Season." The company is English.

Paula Edwards, Edna May, Julia Sanderson, Madeline Gilman and Lulu Glaser are among the prospective opera stars whose careers began in the chorus.

After playing six weeks in Chicago, "The Crozier of God" will play two weeks each in St. Louis, Pittsburgh and Philadelphia, and will then be seen in New York.

The title of the comedy which Augustus Thomas has completed for John Fitch is "De Laney." The title is suggested by "Jim" De Laney, the name of the character which Drew Way will portray.

David Belasco has engaged all the time at the New York Academy of Music from January 1st until the close of the season in May. All the Belasco productions will probably be seen at this house during the year.

Clyde Fitch's play, "The Toast of the Town," which Viola Allen will present next season, is to be made into an opera for Emma Eames' use.

Mr. Fitch has engaged to write the libretto and the music is to be composed by Puccini.

The two leading male roles in Clyde Fitch's play, "The Toast of the Town," which Viola Allen will present this season, will be played by James Carew and A. E. Anson, an English actor. This will be Mr. Anson's first visit to America.

Richard Carré completed a Chicago run of 64 performances in his new farce, "The Mayor of Tokio," last night. He will now leave Chicago for a tour of six weeks on the road, after which he will return to New York for an indefinite engagement.

M. Capus, the author of "La Chateleine" which E. S. Willard produced in this country under the title, "The Brighter Side," is writing a new play especially for Mr. Willard which may be presented here in the winter. The subject or nature of the play has not yet been made known.

E. H. Sothern and Julia Marlowe are soon to return from England for rehearsals of "The Taming of the Shrew," "Twelfth Night" and "The Merchant of Venice," in which they will appear at the Knickerbocker.

The Shah of Persia is still in Belgium. His hotel bill for a week at the Grand Hotel de la Ville was \$20,000. His performances created endless merriment, some might have been deceived by the leading actor in an Oriental burlesque. Every time he descended from his apartments to drive his suite lined up in the vestibule, the hotel marshals came forward, capped on the door with a stout gold-tipped cane, and called out in a solemn voice: "Bow down for the pole of the universe comes."
