SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH-WEST HOMESTEAD REGULATIONS

Any even numbered section of Dominion Lands in Manitoba or the Northwest Provinces, excepting 8 and 20, reserved, may be homesteaded upon by a person who is the sole head of a family or of any male over 18 years of age, to the extent of one-quarter section, of acres, more or less.

Entry may be made personally at the land office for the district in which the land to be taken is situated, or if homesteader desires, he may, on application to the Minister of the Interior, Ottawa, or the local agent in the district in which the land is situated, receive authority for some one to enter for him.

HOMESTEAD DUTIES: A settler has been granted an entry for a homesteaded section of land, the conditions connected therewith under the following regulations: (1) At least six months residence and cultivation of the land in each year during the term of the homestead.

Application for patent may be made at the end of the year, before the Local Agent, Sub-Agent or Homestead Inspector. Before making application for patent the settler must give six months' notice in writing to the Minister of the Interior, Ottawa, of his intention to do so.

WEST MINING REGULATIONS: Coal—Coal lands may be purchased for \$10 per acre, and \$200 per acre. Not more than 320 acres may be acquired by one individual or company. Royalty at the rate of ten cents per ton of 2,000 pounds shall be collected on the gross output.

PLACER mining claims generally 100 feet square; entry fee \$5, renewal \$10. A free miner may obtain two leasehold claims or one of the same value at the discretion of the Minister of the Interior.
