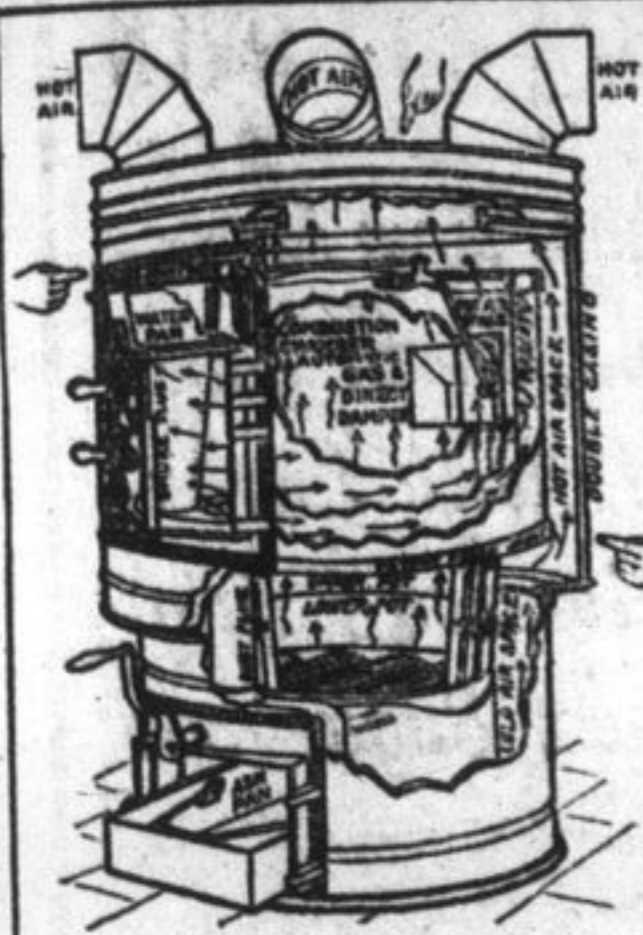

Letter From Greater New York.

MONTH FREIGHTED

WITH MANY ACCIDENTS AND DISASTERS.

Ninth Avenue Accident Grows More Shocking As Investigation Proceeds—Total Depravity An Acknowledged Fact—Some Insurance Disclosure.

Special Correspondence Letter, No. 1,480.

New York, Sept. 22—September, 1905, although only half expired, is freighted more heavily with accidents and disasters than any other month in the present year. The shocking accident on the 9th Avenue elevated grows more terrible as the investigation proceeds; all sorts of rumors and hints are flying as to the cause of the disaster, and all agree that it was caused by a mischievous switch; one witness swears that the switch was all right a few minutes before the train struck it; if that is true, taken in connection with another clue, it avenges the horrible accident. He says the brain reels and the heart grows sick to think of. What incarnate devil misplaced that switch? Another fear-

ful link in the diabolical chain of evidence, is given by the unfortunate motorman on whose shoulders rests the guilt of the horrible accident. He was a new hand and a strike breaker and he declares that four men at his end of the car were calling him "scab" and "rat," and kept on abusing him till a few minutes before the fatal crash. The wretched man was afraid of his life, expecting every moment that he would be seized by his ruffianly assailants and dashed under the wheels of the car he was guiding to ruin and death. The guard whose business it was to know that everything on the road was safe for passing trains, was absent from the watch tower. The motorman looked up and saw that the tower was empty; the train was running at an speed of thirty miles an hour; there was hardly an instant to take in the possibility of danger; it came like the lightning's flash and within a second's time scores of human beings made in the image of God, full of life and hope, fathers and mothers, sons and daughters lay among the ruins of the crushed and blazing cars, a dreadful mass of burning, scalding, shrieking humanity, which no mortal aid could reach and the final hope of help in their terrible sufferings was in death by the mercy of God. We wait with anxious, aching hearts the result of the investigation now proceeding; let the guilty be hunted down; as we hunt down snakes and wolves; let the criminals be convicted let them be dragged from their hiding places to receive their punishment in broad daylight and under the rays of the sun at high noon, that all the world may realize that for such crimes as theirs, sooner or later, the punishment is sure to come in the curses and execrations of the living men and the eternal wrath of the God Almighty. Let the punishment be severe enough to teach those engaged in the business of transportation of passengers on railways, steamboats or other modes of conveyance that they will no longer be allowed to play the hazardous game of life and death for dollars, where the pawns are human lives.

It has long been a mooted question with scientists if such a condition exists in humanity as total depravity. We all remember Jesse Pomeroy, the boy murderer, who for many years was kept in an iron cage like a wild beast in the Massachusetts state prison; his pleasant pastime was to tie little children to posts, or fences, and then to torture them to death with his knife; he did not kill his little victims quickly, he murdered them by inches; their dying screams were music to his ears, he enjoyed them, and scientists finally concluded that total depravity was an accomplished fact. We named a youthful assassin here last week, who could give Jesse Pomeroy twenty points in the game of murder, and then have beaten him, hands down.

For several weeks an eminent capitalist, who was lately mixed up in the investigation now going on of the affairs of the Equitable Life Insurance company, has been receiving letters signed by the "Black Hand," demanding eight hundred dollars, to be left at a certain place, and if he failed to leave the money or attempting to catch them, or made any complaint to the police, death would be his portion. He turned the letters over to the police; a few days after a box was found among Mr. Schoff's mail matter; it was suspected by the postal authorities that there was something

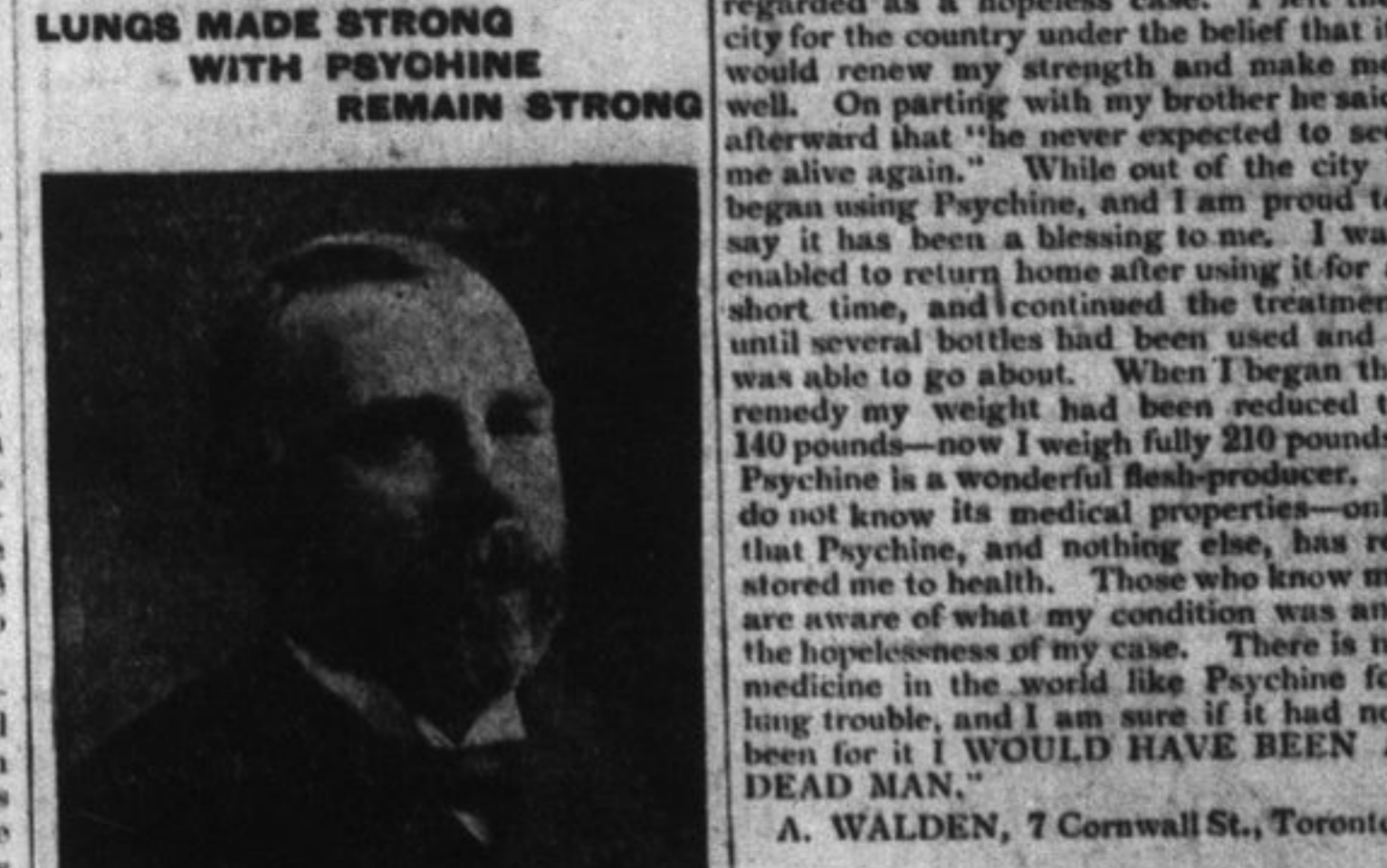
