AMEDAT WAR

Delcasse Said To Have Wanted Collison.

BETWEEN POWERS

HE HAS BEEN FORCED OUT OF OFFICE.

As a Consequence of Clash Between Germany and France Over Morocco—Germany Leaves Britain's Part to British Press.

Cologne, Oct. 10.—The Gazette published an apparently inspired communication, from Berlin, with reference to the story published in the Matin, as to the circumstances in which Foreign Minister Delcasse was forced out of office as a consequence of the Franco-German clash over the affairs of Morocco, and the nearness, at the time, of a war between Germany, France, and England.

The communication says that if the Matin's statements, which are generally attributed to Delcasse, be true, the whole relation stands as a terrible exposure of the minister's policy, which aimed at nothing less than a collision between France and Germany. The article adds: "It will be particularly interesting to note what action Delcasse will take in the matter in Germany; this must be made clear, that our policy was on the right track when we made a determined stand against Delcasse's machinations. As regards the part that Great Britain is alleged to have played, we prefer to stand aside, and let the British press have the precedence in judging."

THE GREATEST CONFUSION

Faces Hungarian Parliament To-Day.

Buda Pest, Oct. 10.—When parliament re-assembles, to-day, it will face a situation of the greatest confusion. The compromise program, which the coalition leaders requested Herr Von Szogonyl Marsech, the Austro-Hungarian ambassador, at Berlin, to submit to the king emperor, has seemingly proved a failure, as his majesty has not yet indicated any attention to receive the ambassador for this purpose.

Great numbers of students will proceed to the parliament buildings, to-day, all wearing mourning, and carrying a black coffin, inscribed: "All possible steps have been taken to secure order during the sitting. The coalition leaders have abandoned their original intention to disregard the royal message again, proroguing the diet. They will protest the king emperor message. According to the newspapers, Gen. Bacon Fejervary has already been re-appointed premier.

ROOSEVELT'S ADMIRERS.

Banquet Him in Room Where He Was Born.

New York, Oct. 10.—A banquet in honor of the president will be given at the Roosevelt Home Club, on his forty-seventh birthday, October 27th, in the room in which he was born, at 28 East 20th street. The president has been invited to be present. The club is determined to preserve the house in which President Roosevelt was born, and to maintain it as a national landmark. The club now numbers about 300 members, and applications are being received daily from all parts of the country. It was organized on October 12th, 1904, by twenty-five admirers of Mr. Roosevelt, and L. P. Glase is the president.

A CHINESE PORT

Will Be Opened Up to Foreign Trade.

Shanghai, Oct. 10.—The victory of Szechuan will open to foreign trade, the city of Wanchuan, on the Yangtze-Kiang, the future terminus of the Hupoh-Szechuan railroad. He thus forestalls an expected demand for the establishment of a foreign settlement there.

China's £1,000,000 Loan. London, Oct. 10.—A despatch to the Chronicle, from Hong Kong, says the government has loaned £1,000,000 to China, to enable this country to acquire the American rights to the Canton-Hankow railway.
