A DOCK SMASHED THREE HUNDRED FEET FALL INTO THE RIVER. Government Will Lose About Two Hundred Thousand Dollars—Several Vessels Have Narrow Escape.

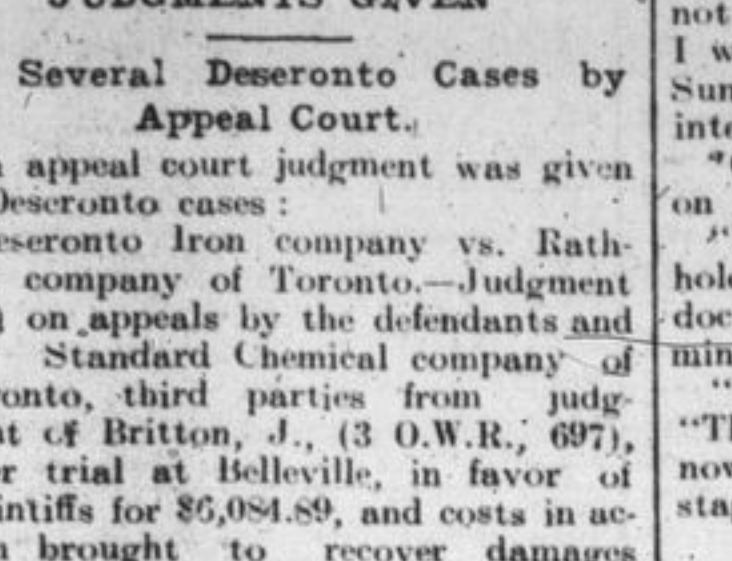

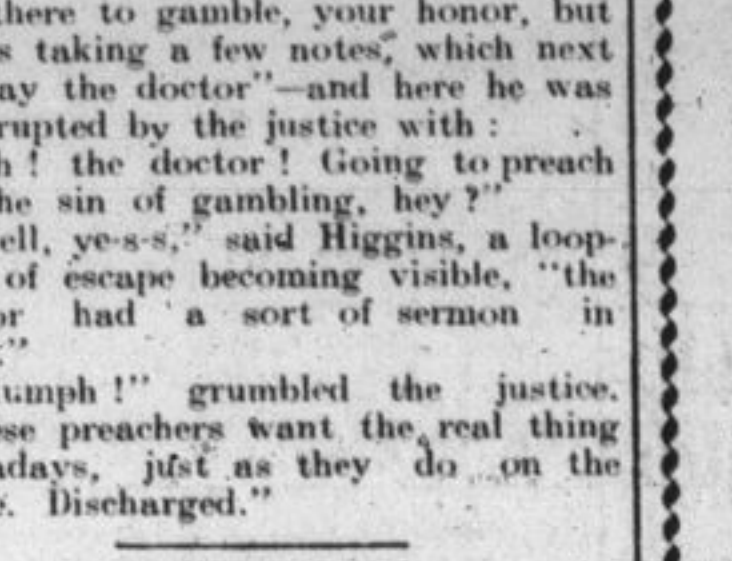
