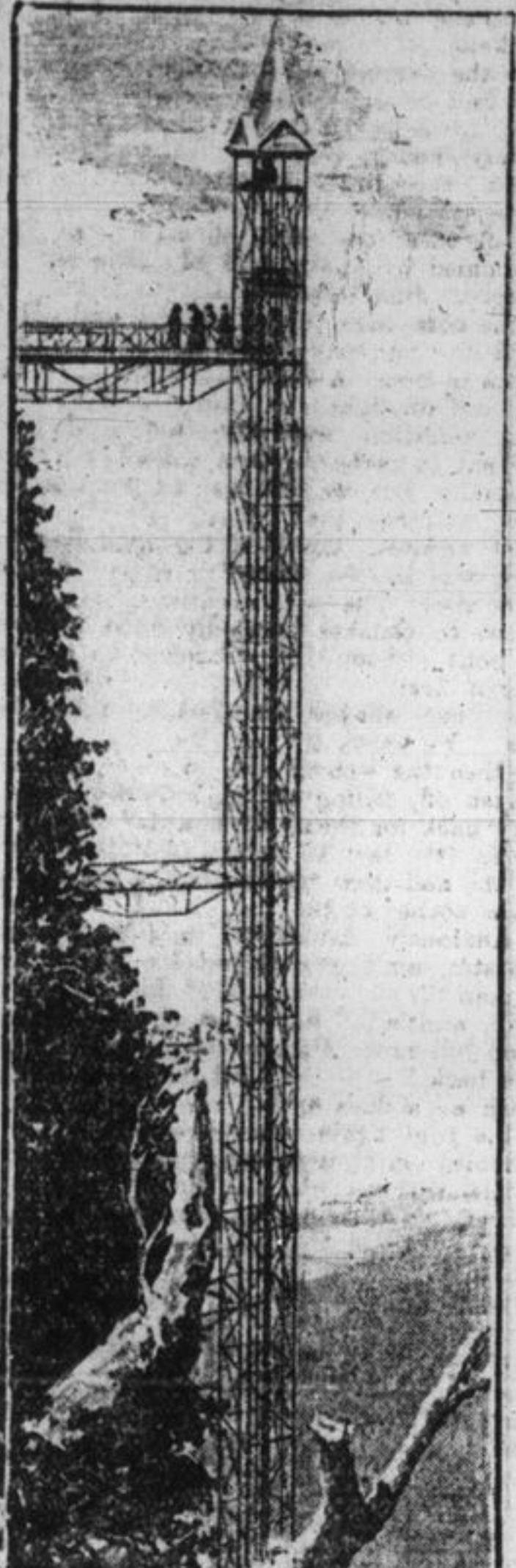

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FASHION'S FORM. Empire Coat For The Little Maid.



In this instance a white satin-faced brocade is warmly interlined to meet the requirements of the weather. The entire conspicuously short body portion is double-breasted, the skirts of circular cut applied with forward turning pleats both back and front, pleats stitched down for a short distance and then left to flare. The belt is posed high up under the arms and decorated with a narrow soutache and heavy stitching. The sleeves are a full tailored design, shirred to the armhole, and with a turnover cuff at the wrist that is caught with a fancy button, fastening down the front. The hat is of white felt, faced with white velvet, and rosettes of white satin ribbon, full and fluffy, are pinned on the bandeau against the hair.

Care Of The Fall Calf. The success in calf raising lies in keeping the animal growing from birth to maturity. Begin early to prepare for winter feeding. While on grass calves should learn to feed on grain. Good shelter should be provided for them at night. Feed clover, alfalfa or other leguminous hay so that they will become accustomed to feeding on roughage before cold winter months. Sheaf oats make a good roughage feed. When winter comes provide the calves with the cleanest quarters possible, affording plenty of bedding and a chance to take exercise. A good winter feed that we have used successfully is equal parts of ground oats, corn and cob meal and bran.
