**THE MUTINY**

**In Sebastopol May Be Kept In Check.**

**POST ARTILLERY**

**CREWS OF THREE SHIPS MAY JOIN MUTINEERS.**

**Moscow Zemstvo Demand Direct Ballot—Radical Press Demands Trial of All Deposed Officials—Address of Thanks for Witte.**

St. Petersburg, Nov. 27.—The sailors, at Kronstadt, are in close telegraphic communication with their comrades at Sebastopol. It is feared that the mutiny at Kronstadt will be renewed, but no fugitives have arrived here. The hope is expressed, in military circles here, that the revolt at Sebastopol will soon run its course. The garrison, numbers 25,000 men of all categories.

The crews of the battleship Pantaleimon, formerly the Kniaz Potemkin, the Evpritchesky, and the cruiser, Ochkoff, attended a meeting of sailors, yesterday afternoon, and decided to join the mutiny. The men of the other vessels refused even to answer to the mutinous sailors' signals.

The city is quiet. Regular military order is strictly preserved by proper sentries. The authorities have posted artillery on the Boulevard, which is the sole avenue of communication between the city and the stronghold of the mutineers, and on the Balaklava road, the only direct access from Admiralty Point. They also have the mutineers completely hemmed in, but are awaiting the arrival of the troops from Simferopol, before attempting to retake the barracks.

**Exceedingly Grave.**

Paris, Nov. 27.—St. Petersburg despatch to the Temps says that Count Witte telegraphed to the president of the Zemstvo congress, at Moscow, stating that what is happening at Sebastopol exceeds in gravity everything that has recently occurred in Russia. He entreats the president to induce the congress to exercise a little moderation.
