SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH-WEST HOMESTEAD REGULATIONS. Any even numbered section of Dominion Lands in Manitoba or the North West Provinces, excepting 4 and 24, numbered, may be homesteaded upon by any person who is the sole head of a family or who is at least 18 years of age...

REMINISCENCES OF THE DARLING HERO OF OLD ENGLAND.

His Immortal Message, "England Expects Every Man Will Do His Duty," and Its Final Evolution - Scotch Soldiers' Consolation When Scotland Was Not Mentioned - The Sailor's Letter - Fatal Determination.

When Nelson visited the Royal Naval Hospital, at Yarmouth, after the battle of Copenhagen, he went round the wards, stopping at every bed, and spoke some cheering and soothing words to every man. At length he stopped opposite to a bed on which was lying a seaman who had lost his right arm close to the shoulder joint...

Call of Duty. Capt. Blackwood, while traveling from Portsmouth to London with despatches, called on Lord Nelson at Merton, where the hero was living in quiet retirement before going on his last voyage.

Home, Sweet Home. When leaving his home at Merton Nelson seemed to have a presentiment that he would never return. He thus expressed himself in his private journal: "Friday night (Sept. 13), at half-past ten I drove from dear, dear Merton, where I left all which I hold dear in this world, to go and serve my King and country. May the great God, whom I adore, enable me to fulfill the expectations of my country!

Valuable Quarters. When Nelson was leaving London to board the Victory for the last time, a quantity of calves' heads was being ordered to be sent down to Portsmouth. His lordship had a farewell dinner party at his house, and while this gathering was in progress the upholsterer arrived with an account of the completion of the goods.
