SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH-WEST HOMESTEAD REGULATIONS. Any even numbered section of Dominion Lands in Manitoba or the Northwest Provinces, excepting 8 and 20, not being reserved, may be homesteaded upon by any person who is the sole head of a family, or who has been married for at least one year, or who is the sole head of a family of one-quarter section, of 160 acres, more or less. Entry may be made personally at the local office for the district in which the land to be taken is situated, or by the Minister of the Interior, Ottawa, the Commissioner of the Interior, Winnipeg, or the local agent for the district in which the land is situated, by authority for some one to make entry for him.

London, Dec. 12.—After adventures recalling the days of the French "terror," Miss Webster, an English governess, has escaped from the heart of Russia, and is now residing in Ealing. Her story brings the scenes of terror and pillage, the horrors of Jew-baiting, and the ruthless savagery of the Black Hundred vividly before English eyes.
