TYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH-WEST

Iny even numbered section of Dominston Lands in Manitaba or the Northwest Provinces, excepting 8 and 26, not eserved, may be homesteaded upon by any berson who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years of age, to the extent of one-quarter section, of 160 mores, more or less.

Entry may be made personally at the local land office for the district in which the land to be taken is savented, or if the homesteader desires, he may, on application to the Minister of the Interior. Ottawa, the Commissioner of Immigration, Winnipeg. or the local agent for the district in which the land is situate, receive authority for some one to make

antry for him.

HOMESTEAD DUTIES: A settler who has been granted an entry for a homestead is required to perform the conditions connected therewith under one the following plans:

(1) At least mx months residence upon a cultivation of the land in each year furing the term of three years.

(2) If the father (or mother if the father is deceased of any person who is eligible to make a homestead entry under the provisions of this Act, resides upon a farm in the vicinity of the land entered for by such person as a homestead, the requirements of this Act as to residence prior to obtaining patent may be satisfied by ack person residing with he father or mother.

(8) If the settler has his permanent residence upon farming land owned by him in the vicinity of his homestead, the requirements of this Act as to residence may be satisfied by residence upon the said land.

APPLICATION FOR PATENT should be made at the end of three years, hetere the Local Agent, Sub-Agent or the Homestead Inspector.

Before making application for patent the settler must give six months' notice in writing to the Commissioner of Dominion Lands at Ottawa, of his intention




